Overview

Crafted by the renowned W.I.B. Crealock, the Pacific Seacraft 40 represents a refined evolution of its predecessors, the 31, 34, 37, and 44.

This yacht for sale boasts a thoughtfully designed deck layout featuring a central king plank for secure footing, an extended bow platform ideal for anchoring, and a windlass boss. The double spreader keel-stepped mast, robust boom-vang, and lines led aft to the cockpit enhance both functionality and safety. Tall stanchions and lifelines provide added security, while eight spacious mooring cleats and bulwarks ensure a safe footing.

Step inside to discover a luxurious interior that includes two private staterooms, a well-appointed head with a separate shower stall, a generous salon, a gourmet galley, and a sizable navigation station equipped with electronics mounting panels.

Access to the engine room is excellent, conveniently located from the cockpit and just behind the companionway ladder.

The PS-40's highly effective underbody design features a long chord fin with external lead ballast that doubles as a grounding shoe, complemented by a robust full skeg to safeguard the rudder. A unique aspect of this design is the propeller, which is housed within the skeg, eliminating any exposed shaft or strut that could be susceptible to logs or shipping containers.

With a moderately deep forefoot, the 40 sails smoothly to weather without excessive pounding. Its impressive performance both on and off the wind consistently achieves average speeds of 7 to 8 knots, translating to greater daily mileage for swift passages. The shrouds are strategically positioned inboard, allowing for tight sheeting angles and exceptional windward capability. The double spreader cutter rig is perfectly suited for offshore adventures, maintaining balance even as wind speeds increase.

Tiyoweh has been meticulously maintained and has undergone significant system upgrades by both her current and previous owners. The current owners are now seeking to downsize to a reliable 32' to 35' sailboat for local cruising and are open to trades. Currently moored in Poulsbo,

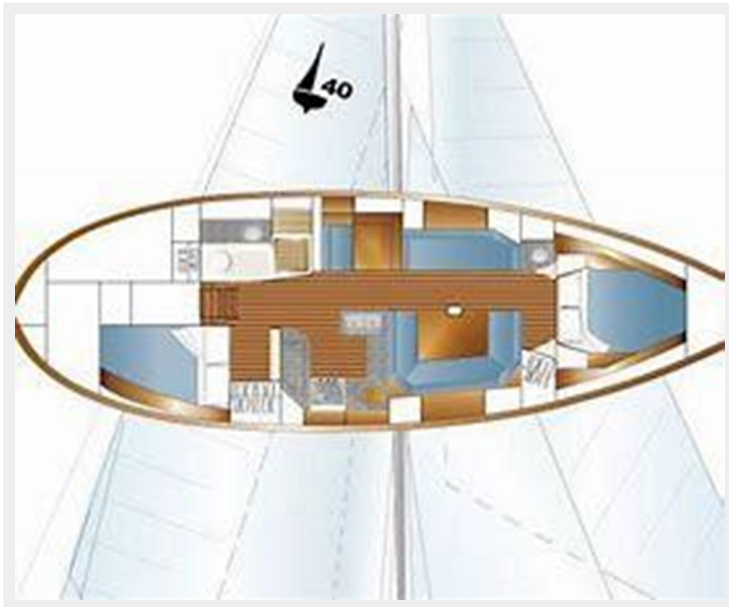

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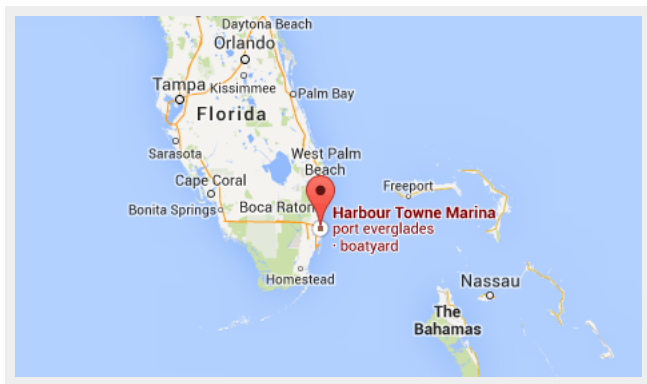
