In 2014, her topsides were meticulously stripped, faired, and finished with Awlgrip by Hodgdon Yachts. From 2019 to 2021, all hardware on the waterways, trunk cabin, and cockpit was removed for Awlgrip application and then expertly re-bedded.

She is set to be launched soon, ready for an ambitious cruising adventure, whether along the coast or across oceans. This broker has extensive experience sailing a sistership on various offshore journeys. The Hinckley Sou'wester 50s are renowned for their seaworthiness and comfort at sea. With her shoal draft and robust bronze centerboard, adjusted with bronze worm gears instead of the usual pendant, she can easily navigate the Intracoastal Waterway when heading south. BACCARA's yawl rig is designed for easy handling, whether by a single sailor or a cruising couple, and her reliable, naturally aspirated Ford Lehman diesel engine ensures dependable power for up to 1,400 nautical miles.

BACCARA features the sought-after B General Arrangement, boasting three cabins and two heads. The owner's stateroom is equipped with a double berth and an ensuite head, providing ample storage for those looking to live aboard. Her L-shaped navigation station, complete with a swivel chair, doubles as an office space. The yacht offers excellent natural ventilation through multiple

Dorade vents and opening hatches, complemented by reverse cycle air-conditioning powered by her 8 kW generator. The spacious cockpit is perfect for entertaining friends, while the cockpit lockers provide generous storage for sails and all necessary gear for extended cruising, ensuring that accommodations remain comfortable and uncluttered. 
