Manufactured between 1963 and 1973 in Hong Kong, over 365 of these exceptional vessels were produced. Esteemed for their craftsmanship, these wooden boats feature yacal frames—an incredibly strong and termite-resistant hardwood—mahogany hulls, and exquisite teak decking throughout. From 1974 onward, "Grand Banks" transitioned to fiberglass construction in Singapore.

Dependable, efficient, and ready for adventure, "Grand Slam" is poised to navigate to San Juan, Canada, Alaska, or any destination you desire. At first sight, it's clear that this Grand Banks has been cherished and meticulously cared for, designed for both cruising and enjoying peaceful moments at anchor away from the hustle and bustle.

The yacht showcases stunning golden Burmese teak both above and below deck, a hallmark of Grand Banks that surpasses the quality of modern laminates. Upon entering, you'll be greeted by glossy teak parquet flooring in the cabin, along with a beautifully crafted teak bar, ample drawer space, a yacht table, and a comfortable settee, complete with additional storage for your journeys, including a second fridge/ice box tucked beneath the settee. For personal comfort, a few steps aft lead you to the spacious master stateroom, which has been custom-refitted with a queen berth, a fully rebuilt head with shower, and added storage options like a hanging locker and chest of drawers. The ambiance is enhanced by a Dickinson "Antarctic" diesel heater, providing a cozy flickering flame and dry warmth throughout the yacht. The forward stateroom features a generous hanging locker, plenty of drawer space, a second head, and a v-berth that can easily convert into a double bunk for

guests with an additional pad.

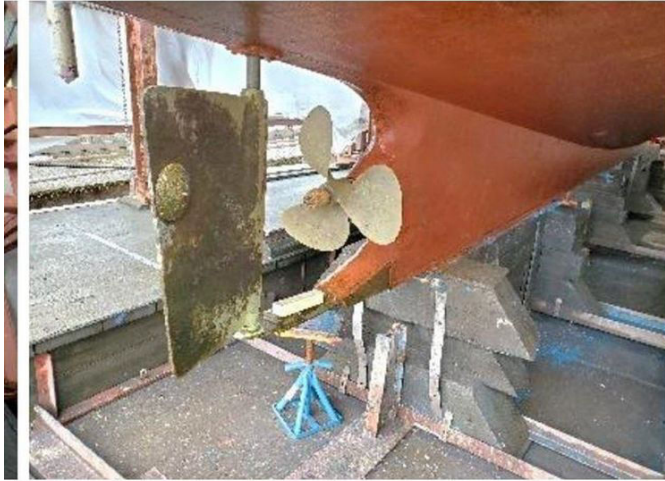
