Selecting a CUSTOM

Opt for the CUSTOM when you prefer a steady 8–10 knot passage, extensive overnight capacity for 20, and the authentic appeal of a wooden-hulled yacht. As a flexible motorsailer within the wider sail yacht category, it is ideal for private cruising where reliable twin inboard diesel power and practical storage and tankage are priorities.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the CUSTOM? A: The CUSTOM from #1 HULL is a **motorsailer** listed under the sail yachts group and specifically in the motorsailers segment, with a **hull** categorized among wooden yachts.

Q: How many people can the yacht accommodate? A: The vessel provides **accommodations** for up to 20 guests and is fitted with **5 heads** . The **crew** section contains 2 cabins offering a total of 6 berths to support operation and guest service.

Q: What engines power the yacht and what are the speeds? A: The yacht is powered by **2 Volvo Penta inboard diesel** engines. Performance is typically a **cruising speed** of 8 kn (9.21 mph) with a **maximum speed** near 10 kn (11.51 mph).

Q: What are the principal dimensions and build details? A: Principal **dimensions** are 119 ft (36.3 m) LOA, 26 ft (8 m) beam, and a 12.303 ft (3.75 m) maximum draft, with a registered 180 **gross tonnage** . The boat is a **monohull** featuring a wood deck and wooden construction.

Owner Experience Review

Owners attracted to CUSTOM builds from #1 HULL often pursue family cruising, Mediterranean charter operations, or a full live aboard lifestyle. Several examples are configured with five cabins, including a full beam master, typically accommodating around ten guests in comfortable staterooms, and refits commonly reveal rich solid wood and mahogany joinery complemented by traditional teak decks. As one owner succinctly described it, "It is a beautiful boat."

On the water, comparable motorsailer listings indicate cruise speeds near 10 knots with peak numbers of 12–13 knots reported on some boats, and many

owners comment that the yachts are "good under sail and motor" once rigging and systems work are complete. That said, owners and forum discussions caution that bespoke hull modifications will affect handling characteristics, and substandard repair work can produce issues such as fiberglass waterlogging—making thorough surveys and comprehensive refit records essential. Maintenance demands are meaningful; numerous boats underwent major rebuilds in 2019–2020 replacing mechanical, electrical, and rig systems—yet another owner observed, "The hull is very solid and most of my work is pumps and cosmetic."

Pros and Cons

- Generous five cabin arrangements with a full beam master can host about ten guests for family cruising or charter.
- After high quality refits, many examples perform well under both sail and power with balanced handling.
- Owners frequently praise the hull solidity, noting routine maintenance often concerns pumps and appearance.
- Custom hull alterations can change handling, and poor workmanship may lead to problems such as fiberglass waterlogging.
- Significant refit and ongoing maintenance requirements, with many vessels undergoing extensive 2019–2020 overhauls.
- Performance on comparable boats is moderate, generally around a 10 kn cruise and 12–13 kn maximum.
