Q1: What type of yacht is the Dodge Triple Cockpit? A1: It is a classic motor yacht constructed with a wooden hull, manufactured by #1 HULL. Notable attributes include a **single inboard engine** and **wood construction** .

Q2: What are the principal dimensions? A2: The **LOA** is 26 ft (8.05 m) and the **beam** is 7 ft (2.13 m), offering well-proportioned lines for this motor yacht.

Q3: What engine and fuel system does it have? A3: The boat is powered by **1 x Chrysler ( Inboard , Gas )** . The **fuel capacity** is 30 gallons, suitable for straightforward day cruising.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners often present the Dodge Triple Cockpit from #1 HULL as a centerpiece at ACBS and concours events, where well-restored examples have frequently taken "Skippers Choice" honors. Many are campaigned in exhibition races and lake demonstrations—summer appearances at Lake Tahoe are not uncommon—or kept as trailerable freshwater dayboats that are typically stored indoors and used sporadically, perhaps monthly or for short seasonal runs. The triple open-cockpit configuration and period-correct upholstery—frequently redone by concours upholsterers—emphasize its role as a short-day runabout rather than a cruising vessel, with minimal modern electronics and little in the way of weather protection.

On the water it provides the quintessential runabout sensation on calm inland waters; it is not designed for offshore passages or heavy seas. Owners report period variations such as port-side steering on certain 1929 examples, and note that the light, narrow hull can display a portward list when operated solo, evening out as additional passengers board. Powerplants vary widely: some retain rebuilt original Lycoming straight-8 or V12 engines, while many have been repowered for greater reliability and performance—for example a 280 hp 1965 Chrysler 413 V 8 or a Marine Power 350 ci V 8. Extensive wooden restorations are common, sometimes replacing nearly all planking, and owners often employ modern bedding and epoxy systems—3M 5200, West System, and improved West System bottoms—to reduce maintenance, enable dry launching/mooring, and help preserve freshwater boats that

frequently have never seen saltwater.

## Pros and Cons

- Proven show-circuit appeal, with restored examples earning "Skippers Choice" at ACBS/concours events.
- Smooth, graceful ride on calm inland waters with classic runabout character.
- Modern bottoms and common repower paths (e.g., Chrysler 413 or 350-ci V8) improve reliability and ease of use.
- Not intended for offshore or rough-water use.
- Very limited modern amenities and weather shelter given the three open cockpits.
- Extensive wood restoration and epoxy/bedding work are commonly required and can be costly.
