OVERVIEW

Built by ABEKING & RASMUSSEN, the 170 ft (52 m) Custom is an elegant motor yacht featuring a steel hull and a full displacement arrangement. Designed to cruise comfortably at 14 knots and reach up to 16 knots, it combines seaworthiness with substantial onboard volume for prolonged voyages. This yacht is listed through Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the Custom? A: It is a motor yacht built with a steel hull and configured as a full displacement vessel, intended for capable and comfortable long distance passagemaking.

Q: What are the key performance figures? A: The **cruise speed** is 14 kn (16.11 mph) and the **maximum speed** is 16 kn (18.41 mph), driven by **2 x CAT** inboard **diesel** engines.

Q: How many guests and crew can be accommodated? A: The **accommodation count** is 12 with **sleeps** for 6, complemented by **7 heads** and **7 crew cabins** to support professional operation.

Q: Who created the interior and what is the build pedigree? A: The **interior design** is by Luigi Sturchio & Ath. Kyratsou, and the vessel is constructed by ABEKING & RASMUSSEN, a shipyard noted for its build excellence.

At sea these yachts are respected for their ocean capable manners and confident seakeeping on extended passages; larger designs are frequently praised for quiet, powerful propulsion, and SWATH or heavy displacement solutions receive high marks for outstanding stability in rough conditions—qualities that align well with

expeditionary itineraries.

Daily life aboard emphasizes spaciousness, abundant natural light, and intuitive circulation. Owners and captains note the benefit of generous interior volume and large windows that flood cabins with daylight and expand sightlines, alongside guest-centric layouts that accommodate both family living and charter turnover; many owners favor an elevated forward deck as a preferred vantage point in fair weather. From an ownership perspective, feedback indicates the yard honors warranties and provides prompt support, and clients often return for significant refits and redeliveries. Simultaneously, the fully bespoke nature of a Custom requires meticulous commissioning plans, comprehensive spares inventories, and a seasoned crew to ensure reliable long-term operation; individual needs will vary by build.

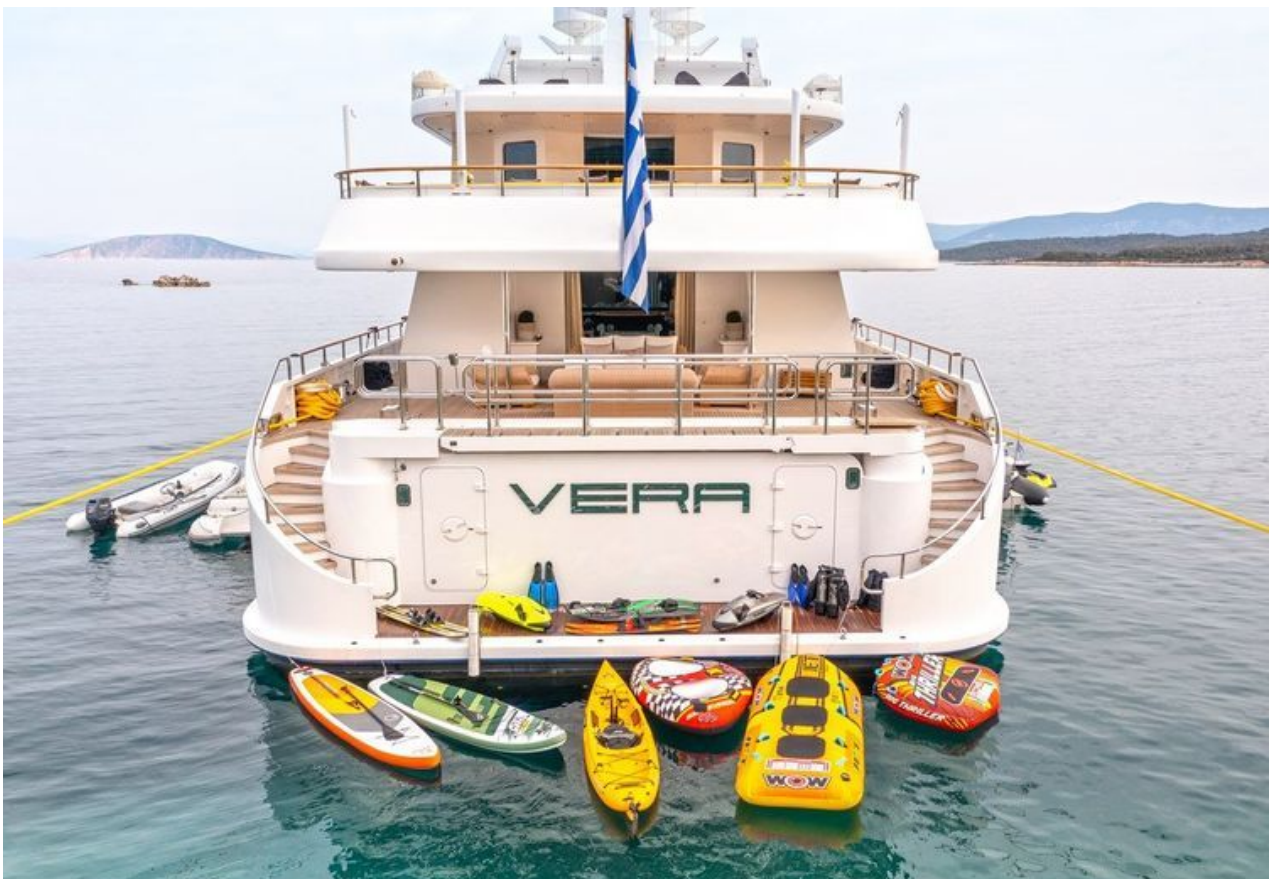
