OVERVIEW

The 48 Coupe from Absolute Yachts is a modern motor yacht built within the wider motor yachts segment. Its hull combines fiberglass and plastic construction with a fiberglass deck. This 48-foot platform is offered through Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales for buyers seeking a capable, contemporary cruising yacht.

Selecting a 48 Coupe

Opting for the 48 Coupe focuses on a blend of usable interior volume and manageable handling. Measuring 48 ft (14.63 m) LOA with a 14 ft (4.52 m) beam, the yacht delivers ample space without compromising nimbleness. Twin Volvo I/O diesel powerplants support an economical 25 kn (28.77 mph) cruise and a top end near 28 kn (32.22 mph). With 140.02 gallons of fresh water and 422.62 gallons of fuel aboard, the model is set up for extended weekend use, while two heads add everyday convenience. Constructed with a fiberglass and plastic hull and a fiberglass deck, the design prioritizes longevity and straightforward maintenance.

- What type of yacht is the 48 Coupe? It is a motor yacht in the motor yachts segment, produced by Absolute Yachts with a fiberglass and plastic hull and a fiberglass deck.
- How fast does it go? The **cruising speed** is approximately 25 kn (28.77 mph) and the **maximum speed** is about 28 kn (32.22 mph), providing an efficient performance range for a 48-foot yacht.

- What engines power the yacht? **Engines:** 2 x **Volvo I/O, Diesel** . This twin setup delivers straightforward handling and reliable cruise behavior.
- What are the key dimensions? **LOA:** 48 ft (14.63 m); **Beam:** 14 ft (4.52 m). These measurements yield a stable platform that remains marina-friendly.
- What are the main capacities and amenities onboard? **Fuel capacity:** 422.62 gal; **Fresh water:** 140.02 gal; **Heads:** These specifications support comfortable weekend cruising and guest accommodation.

Owner Experience Review

Many owners select the 48 Coupe from Absolute Yachts for family cruising and weekend getaways, appreciating its three-stateroom, two-head arrangement that suits children and overnight visitors. The salon's open layout with expansive glazing provides nearly all-around visibility, while the helm is laid out for ergonomic operation and offers full standing headroom—features that reduce fatigue during long days aboard. At anchor, the versatile aft cockpit terrace of roughly 102 sq ft converts easily between lounge and dining modes, and optional solar panels integrated into the roof (noted up to about ~2.5 kW) can extend electrical independence while stationary.

When underway, pilots commonly report that the 48 Coupe feels stable and reassuring. Twin Volvo Penta D6 IPS650s typically return efficient cruise performance near ~25 kt with top speeds in the ~27–28 kt band, making the yacht suitable for island runs and coastal hops. For tight maneuvering, the IPS joystick, Assisted Docking, DockSense, proportional bow thruster, and dynamic positioning provide precise control for owner-operators. Volvo's Active Ride Control smooths roll and roll-coupled lean in turns; a number of reviewers say they switch it off when they want a more responsive helm.

On ownership and maintenance, routine care for the IPS units (including pod/gear-oil changes, scheduled upkeep, and software/firmware updates per

Volvo's recommendations) is expected. Testers praise an engine room that is relatively generous for a boat of this size, which simplifies access and servicing. Fuel capacity and consumption figures are key considerations for range planning and operating budgets, and owners should anticipate higher running costs when cruising at the upper end of the speed range.

Pros and Cons

- Three staterooms and two heads support family weekending and flexible guest arrangements.
- IPS joystick, Assisted Docking, DockSense, bow thruster, and dynamic positioning make owner-operator docking precise and low stress.
- Panoramic glazing, ergonomic helm, and a 102 sq ft reconfigurable cockpit terrace suit day trips and entertaining at anchor.
- IPS ownership entails pod/gear-oil service and reliance on authorized Volvo support.
- Running at higher cruise speeds increases fuel consumption and overall operating costs.
- Active Ride Control tempers turning response unless disengaged for sharper handling.
