## OVERVIEW

---

Crafted for discerning cruising, the 52 Fly from Absolute Yachts is a motor yacht built on a fiberglass and plastic hull. Measuring 52 ft (15.85 m) LOA with a 15 ft (4.67 m) beam, it merges efficient cruising performance with comfortable onboard living, powered by twin Volvo inboard diesel units and equipped with two heads. This model is listed through Shestakov Yacht Sales, where broker Andrey Shestakov provides tailored support throughout the buying process.

### Selecting a 52 Fly

---

- Opt for this model if you prioritize a steady 25 knot cruise (28.77 mph) and the ability to push up to 30 kn (34.52 mph) for faster coastal hops.
- The 475 gallon fuel tank and 172 gallon freshwater capacity make it easier to extend weekends away from marina stops.
- Verify that your usual cruising grounds can accommodate a draft of 15.037 ft (4.5833 m).
- Favor the durability and maintainability of a fiberglass and plastic hull in a refined motor yacht package.

### Features of the Model

- Hull and deck proportions tuned for balanced space and seakeeping: 52 ft (15.85 m) LOA and a 15 ft (4.67 m) beam.

- Twin Volvo inboard diesel engines provide dependable propulsion and good handling characteristics.

- Structural build: fiberglass and plastic hull paired with a fiberglass deck.
- Serviceable tankage: 475 gal fuel capacity and 172 gal freshwater capacity support extended cruising.

## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What is the yacht's exact category and hull type? A: The 52 Fly is classified as a motor yacht and is built with a fiberglass and plastic hull and a fiberglass deck, combining **strength** , **efficiency** , and **low maintenance** .

Q: How fast can it go? A: The model delivers a typical **cruise speed** of 25 kn (28.77 mph) and a **maximum speed** of 30 kn (34.52 mph), making it well suited to efficient passage-making and weekend runs.

Q: What powers the yacht? A: The propulsion package comprises **twin** Volvo **inboard diesel** engines, offering dependable power and straightforward service routines.

Q: What are the key dimensions and capacities? A: The yacht measures **LOA** 52 ft (15.85 m) with a **beam** of 15 ft (4.67 m) and a **draft** of 15.037 ft (4.5833 m). It includes **two heads** , **fuel** capacity of 475 gal, and **water** capacity of 172 gal.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners frequently select the 52 Fly as a manageable owner operator vessel for family cruising; many examples also operate as Mediterranean day charter boats under a captain, accommodating up to a dozen guests. The model has undergone iterative refinements from its initial hulls in 2015, with notable updates around 2017 and further revisions in 2022–2023, reflecting Absolute Yachts' emphasis on practical onboard living and simplified handling.

On the water, owners report handling that feels “surprisingly responsive,” with a tight turning radius near three boat lengths. Performance accounts

consistently reference a comfortable fast cruise near 25 knots and peak speeds close to 30 knots, while slower, economical steaming around 10 knots is also noted. Volvo Penta IPS pod installations are credited with excellent low speed maneuverability in marinas—an advantage for owner operators—though forums and owner reports caution that these systems require specialist maintenance and have had occasional clutch/drive issues historically, improvements notwithstanding, which can complicate repairs.

The interior is widely commended for a three stateroom arrangement, bright modern styling with large hullside glazing, an aft galley plan, and generous cockpit lounging, plus finishes and storage likened to hotel standards and a very livable flybridge. Conversely, the forward owner's cabin layout can be divisive and may not suit every buyer. Engine room and lazarette access are generally adequate, but optional equipment such as Seakeeper gyros and auxiliary gensets add to the list of service items, underscoring the importance of proactive maintenance planning for sustained ownership satisfaction.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Responsive handling with IPS and a tight turning circle make owner operation straightforward.
- Comfortable fast cruise around 25 knots with top speeds near 30 knots.
- Bright, contemporary three stateroom layout with aft galley and strong day to day livability.
- IPS pod drives require specialist servicing and can increase ownership costs.
- Forward owner's cabin layout may not suit all preferences.
- Additional systems like Seakeeper gyros and a genset add maintenance complexity.
