OVERVIEW

The 58 Navetta from Absolute Yachts is a modern motor yacht built on a fiberglass construction platform featuring a planing hull. It delivers a top speed around 23 knots and offers comfortable accommodations for six guests plus dedicated crew quarters. Shestakov Yacht Sales presents this model, with broker Andrey Shestakov handling inquiries.

Selecting a 58 Navetta

When considering a 58-foot yacht that combines twin inboard diesel power, a generous beam, and true overnight capabilities, the 58 Navetta is a compelling option. The arrangement of two heads and a separate crew cabin for two makes it well suited to an owner who occasionally operates the boat themselves but also wants the option of crewed service, or for families seeking privacy and onboard support.

Configured as a motor yacht with a fiberglass construction planing hull, this model offers assured performance along with practical fuel and freshwater capacities, simplifying both weekend getaways and extended coastal cruising plans.

- Twin inboard diesel propulsion by Volvo Penta for dependable operation
- Planing hull for responsive handling and up to 23 knots (26.47 mph) of top speed
- Broad 16 ft beam for stable living spaces underway and at anchor
- Accommodations for up to 6 guests with 2 heads, plus a crew cabin for 2
- Construction highlights: fiberglass and plastic hull with GRP deck

- Practical tankage for comfort on longer stays: 634.01 gal fuel and 158.5 gal water

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the 58 Navetta? A: The **category** is a motor yacht built on a **planing** hull form with fiberglass hull construction.

Q: Who is the builder of this model? A: The 58 Navetta is manufactured by **Absolute Yachts**, a builder known for **quality** and **innovation** in higher-end motor yachts.

Q: What are the performance highlights? A: Powered by twin **Volvo Penta inboard diesel** engines, the vessel achieves a **maximum speed** of 23 knots (26.47 mph), delivering responsive and capable handling.

Q: How is the yacht arranged for guests and crew? A: The layout provides **accommodation** for up to 6 guests with **2 heads**, plus a **crew** cabin for 2, offering a balance between privacy and onboard service.

Q: What are the key dimensions and capacities? A: Key **dimensions** are 58 ft LOA, 16 ft beam, and a **draft** of 8.694 ft. Tankage includes 634.01 gal **fuel** and 158.5 gal **water**, enabling longer periods aboard.

Owner Experience Review

Owners running the 58 Navetta from Absolute Yachts as owner-operators find it well suited to lengthy passages and relaxed family weekends, while also adapting to social day trips — with a certified day capacity as high as 14. At sea the motion is reported as notably soft, with minimal pounding in about 1.5 m swell, and close-quarters handling is described as predictable thanks to the IPS joystick in combination with a bow thruster. Owners note an economical cruising band near 15 knots; factory figures hint at top speeds in the high-20s, though actual speeds often fall short, particularly if drives or props suffer from marine growth.

A frequent compliment from owners and reviewers is the high-quality interior fitout and expansive salon vistas. The accommodation plan features a full-beam master and a bow VIP within a three-ensuite configuration, supported by a galley-to-cockpit arrangement that facilitates entertaining. Multiple exterior living areas — including a large covered flybridge lounge, bow sunpad, and aft cockpit — let groups spread out comfortably. Sleeping capacity is flexible for 6–8 guests plus crew, with ample headroom and storage, and the crew cabin provides convenient access to the engine room.

Serviceability is praised: there are several access points, including an entry via the crew-shower hatch, and good clearance to the D8 IPS units along with unobstructed reach to strainers and filters. The flip side, echoed across owner forums, is that Volvo Penta IPS systems require rigorous maintenance; some owners report costly repairs or warranty complications, and fouling on drives and props can erode both top speed and fuel economy. Routine hull and drive cleaning, application of PropSpeed, and regular replacement of IPS fluids and consumables are treated as standard ongoing expenses.

Pros and Cons

- Soft offshore ride and predictable close-quarters control with the IPS joystick and bow thruster.
- Flexible layout that serves family cruising, owner-operator passages, and day charters up to 14 guests.
- Impressive interior execution with panoramic salon views and three ensuite cabins, including a full-beam master.
- Real-world top speed commonly falls short of factory claims, particularly when drives and props are fouled.
- Volvo Penta IPS demands disciplined upkeep; some owners have experienced expensive repairs and warranty issues.
- Routine drive cleaning, PropSpeed application, and IPS fluids/consumables

contribute to ongoing operating costs.
