OVERVIEW

Commissioned for owners who prize artisanal construction and long range capability, the Custom Built Sailing Yacht from ADA YACHT WORKS is a tailor made sail yacht laid out as a cruising ketch built on a wooden hull. This one off project is offered through Andrey Shestakov and the international brokerage team at Shestakov Yacht Sales.

Selecting a Custom Built Sailing Yacht

Opting for the Custom Built Sailing Yacht places emphasis on generous proportions, onboard comfort and proven engineering systems. Measuring 39 m (128 ft) with an 8 m (26 ft) beam in a Monohull form, the yacht delivers a balance of interior volume and seakeeping ability. Configured as a cruising ketch, the sail plan is designed for flexible passagemaking. Twin inboard **Cummins** diesel engines provide surefooted handling and reliable progress at a 10 knot cruise (11.51 mph). A Wood Epoxy deck complements the wooden hull construction, while interiors by Hale DOKE create an elegant living environment. The layout accommodates 8 guests and includes 3 crew cabins to preserve separate guest and service zones.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the Custom Built Sailing Yacht? A: It is a sail yacht arranged as a cruising ketch built on a wooden hull in a Monohull configuration by ADA YACHT WORKS.

Q: How many people can it accommodate, and what about crew spaces? A: The yacht offers **accommodations for 8** and is fitted with **3 crew cabins** , providing a clear separation between guest areas and crew quarters.

Q: What are the key dimensions and tonnage? A: The overall length is **128 ft (39 m)** , beam **26 ft (8 m)** , maximum draft **13.287 ft (4.05 m)** , and the yacht measures **183 GT** gross tonnage.

Q: What propulsion and performance details stand out? A: Twin **Cummins diesel inboard** engines drive the vessel, enabling a steady **10 knot cruise** (11.51 mph) for comfortable passages.

Owner Experience Review

Owners commissioning the Custom Built Sailing Yacht from ADA YACHT WORKS commonly pursue extended private cruising and, in some cases, well managed luxury charter operations. Recent Ada projects show layouts that can carry up to 12 guests supported by multi member crews (for example, All About U with a crew of nine), reflecting a tendency toward professionally crewed programs rather than short handed weekend use.

Underway, larger Ada designs typically favor full displacement hulls that

provide a comfortable motion at displacement speeds. Benchmarks from comparable builds help set expectations: All About U is recorded around 12 knots cruising and about 15 knots maximum; wood/epoxy gulet style yachts such as LE PIETRE are generally listed around 10–12 knots; and one 47 m Dykstra designed schooner project has been reported capable of at least 23 knots under sail, underscoring the variation by design brief.

Aboard, owners highlight expansive bespoke cabins and sociable deck spaces—examples span six cabin arrangements for 12 guests, foredeck lounges, beach club concepts and even pools on 35–50 m projects—paired with practical, well lit interiors and fully equipped galleys noted in broker presentations. Maintenance expectations align with conventional classed superyacht practice for ADA YACHT WORKS builds: listings document refits including new teak decks, engine room overhauls and refreshed RINA surveys. Savvy owners budget for periodic major refits and scheduled class survey cycles on larger custom commissions.

Pros and Cons

- Customizable layouts with large social decks and bright, practical interiors make these yachts well suited to private cruising and charter activities.
- Full displacement hulls deliver a comfortable, predictable ride with cruise speeds reflective of comparable Ada vessels.
- Constructed to class, these builds follow established superyacht service regimes and have documented refit pathways.
- The majority of projects are designed for multi person professional crews, which limits viability for true owner operator use.
- Periodic significant refits, teak deck renewals and class survey requirements introduce downtime and additional operating expenses.
- Performance and internal arrangement differ substantially by designer and naval architect, so each custom brief requires careful evaluation.
