OVERVIEW

Presented by Shestakov Yacht Sales and broker Andrey Shestakov, the 30 mtr by Admiral is a performance-oriented motor yacht built on an aluminum hull. It delivers a 28-knot cruising pace and up to 31 knots at top end, with hull engineering from Admiral Yachts and interior styling by Laura Baldoni de Gorga.

Selecting a 30 mtr

Opt for this model when you want a responsive monohull measuring 101 ft (30.86 m) LOA with a 23 ft (7.11 m) beam. At 183 gross tons and offering accommodation for 10 with sleeping berths for 8 and 10 heads, it is well suited to family cruising and entertaining guests. Twin MTU inboard diesels, a 5,864-gallon fuel tank, 1,083 gallons of potable water, and two crew cabins (four berths) make this yacht capable of fast, comfortable passages.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the 30 mtr? A: This model is a motor yacht built with an aluminum hull by Admiral.

Q: How fast can it go? A: The 30 mtr delivers a **cruising speed** of 28 knots (32.22 mph) and a **top speed** of 31 knots (35.67 mph).

Q: How many people can it accommodate? A: The yacht's **accommodation** is listed as 10, with **sleeping** capacity for 8 and **heads** totaling 10; the **crew** area includes 2 cabins totaling 4 berths.

Q: What engines power the yacht? A: Propulsion comes from two **MTU Inboard Diesel** engines aboard the 30 mtr.

Owner Experience Review

Owners of the 30 mtr produced by Admiral typically divide use between private family voyages and charter operations, with multiple examples showing documented charter history. Frequent activities include day hosting and weekend get-togethers, supported by expansive deck zones, a convenient swim platform, and ample storage for several water toys. The size and layout also make this platform well suited to owner-operated cruising.

On the water, the 30 mtr is reported as a rapid planing motor yacht. Owner reports commonly place economical cruising between 22–25 knots with peak performance around 28–29 knots, driven by responsive twin MTU packages.

Actual speeds depend on build specification; some listings report cruising as high as 28 knots and top speeds near 30 knots.

Inside, the 30 mtr is offered in layouts from four to six cabins plus crew quarters, typically hosting 8 guests and in some configurations accommodating as many as 12. Spacious salons, generous flybridge entertaining areas, and galley arrangements suitable for professional service are common features, and many examples have undergone refits to refresh interiors. Ownership necessitates realistic maintenance planning: scheduled heavy servicing for MTU engines and ZF transmissions, vigilance against aluminium corrosion with ongoing teak maintenance, and awareness of generator fuel consumption under hotel loads (some listings note roughly 200 L/day), with periodic cosmetic and systems refits being routine.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile for both private cruising and charter, offering extensive deck space for socialising and easy water access.
- Quick and agile handling with typical cruising between 22–25 knots and peaks near 28–29 knots.
- Flexible accommodation plans ranging from 4–6 cabins with crew quarters; commonly sleeps 8 guests and can reach up to 12 depending on layout.
- Owners should expect routine heavy maintenance cycles for MTU engines and ZF gearboxes.
- Aluminium hull with teak decking requires diligent corrosion monitoring and ongoing teak care.
- Generator fuel consumption under hotel loads and related servicing are significant considerations (some listings cite ~200 L/day), and periodic refits are often necessary.

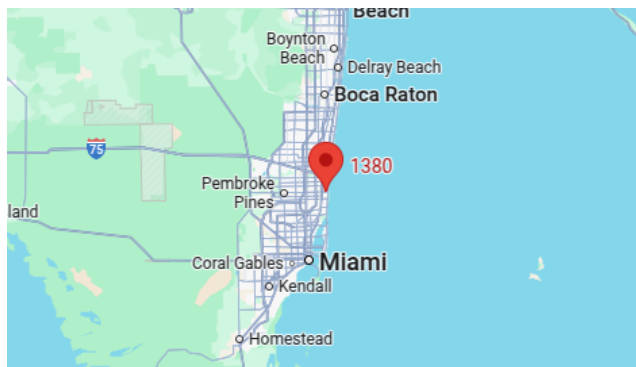
