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OVERVIEW

Crafted by Admiral, the IMPERO 40 is a 39.62 m (130 ft) motor yacht listed in the motor-yacht segment. Built on an all aluminum hull with a Semi Displacement form, it is offered through Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov. The design pairs twin MTU inboard diesel propulsion with a reported 14–20 knot performance range and a gross tonnage of 479 GT.

Selecting a IMPERO 40

Choosing the IMPERO 40 is about finding equilibrium between onboard volume and seakeeping: a 27 ft (8.46 m) beam creates roomy decks and interiors, while the 39.62 m LOA ensures a strong presence. The yacht's twin MTU inboard diesels provide dependable drive, and with a typical cruise of 14 kn (16.11 mph) and a maximum near 20 kn (23.02 mph), plus large fuel (13,473 gal) and fresh water (2,368 gal) tanks, it is aimed at owners who want sensible speed without compromising onboard space or comfort.

Q: What are the speeds of the IMPERO 40? A: The yacht has a **cruising speed** of **14 knots** (16.11 mph) and a **maximum speed** of **20 knots** (23.02 mph).

Q: How many people can it accommodate, and how many crew cabins are there? A: The yacht **accommodates** up to **11 guests** and provides **4 crew cabins** for professional operation.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and masters who have operated the IMPERO 40 from Admiral commonly describe it as a quiet, guest oriented 40 meter with wide operational capability. Early deliveries from 2013 were primarily used for private long range cruising — including U.S. and Caribbean itineraries — while later hulls have successfully entered premium charter rotations. The layout, which often features an on deck owner's stateroom, four to five guest cabins below, expansive exterior entertaining areas, and significant tender/beach facilities, supports both family cruising and full service charter operations.

At sea, owners report very low noise and vibration at delivery, and RINA classed examples are frequently praised for their overall refinement. The

semi displacement hull is most economical in the 10–14 knot range, with a common cruise around 14 knots and top speeds typically reaching about 18–20 knots depending on the selected power package. Zero speed stabilizers and a shallow draft of about 1.9 m help the yacht remain steady at anchor and allow access to shallower bays.

Equipment and machinery layouts differ by hull: some yachts are fitted with twin Caterpillar C32s while others carry MTU 12V2000s, which alters service intervals and parts logistics. Hybrid variants marketed for the IMPERO 40 offer electric or variable speed generator modes for very low speed operation near 10 knots, but these configurations require more specialist vendor support than conventional installations. Public forums do not indicate systemic mechanical failures; however, because engine room access and technical documentation are infrequently published, prospective buyers should rely on professional surveys and yard service records rather than forum postings for maintenance history.

Pros and Cons

- Exceptionally quiet and low vibration running reported by press and forum observers.
- Semi displacement efficiency suits 10–14 knot passages, with shallow ~1.9 m draft aiding access to bays and anchorages.
- Owner friendly layout (on deck master, 4–5 guest cabins, large sundeck, beach club, tender garage) works for private use or charter.
- Performance, fuel burn, and range vary materially by engine package, complicating like for like comparisons.
- Hybrid/variable speed generator options add system complexity and require specialized vendor support.
- Limited public engine room documentation and scarce long term owner fault data mean due diligence depends on surveys and yard records.

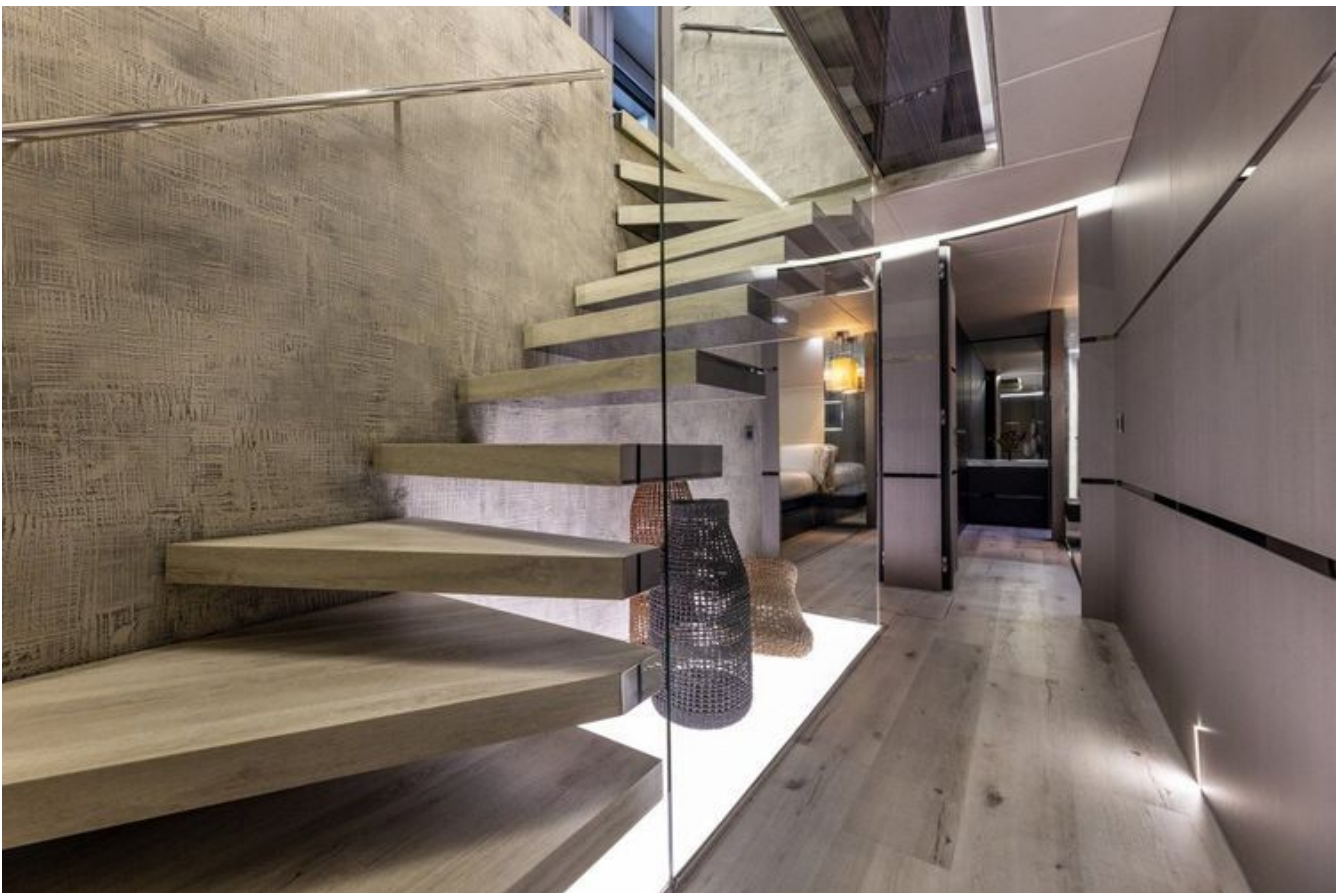
