Q: What type of boat is the 47 Reaper? A: The 47 Reaper is a motor yacht built around a center console design by ADRENALINE POWERBOATS INTER INC. The **model** pairs open-deck versatility with an onboard **head** for all-day comfort.

Q: What are the engines and fuel type? A: **Engines** : five Mercury outboards. **Fuel type** : **Gas** . This layout provides owners with straightforward maintenance and substantial thrust.

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: **LOA** is 47 ft (14.33 m) and **Beam** is 12 ft

(3.66 m), delivering a stable platform suitable for guests, gear, and coastal passages.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and event coverage highlight the 47 Reaper from ADRENALINE POWERBOATS INTER INC as a high-profile weekend and poker-run platform, commonly spotted at headline events such as Destin. It suits day-cruising and light sport-fishing roles, though many owners position it as a luxurious family retreat thanks to a refined cabin and galley; some owners even hesitate to bring fish aboard to protect the upscale interior. Onboard systems support that lifestyle with 43-gallon freshwater and 43-gallon waste capacity.

On the water, owners and press report a performance-oriented character: comfortable cruising in the low 90s mph with 90-plus mph capability, and media noting near-100-mph potential when fitted with five 500R outboards. The hull is a V-bottom with a 24-degree transom deadrise and uses vacuum-infused epoxy construction, contributing to the composed ride and capable handling noted by forum contributors—one owner remarked, “Everything on this boat not only looks the part it plays the part.” The model’s dockside presence distinguishes it among V-bottom center consoles.

Ownership considerations focus on the powertrain: multiple Mercury Racing

outboards (builder guidance includes up to 2,250 hp via quint 450R) provide exceptional performance but carry elevated routine service costs. The outboard configuration simplifies maintenance access, complemented by carbon-fiber structural bonding around engine mounts, and the 416-gallon fuel tank supports extended high-speed legs—yet careful range planning is still advised. Early forum discussions show strong enthusiasm and delivery updates, without consolidated reports of systemic failures in early production.

Pros and Cons

- High-performance cruise in the low 90s mph with 90+ mph capability and confident V bottom handling.
- Luxury interior and social deck ergonomics, featuring a cabin, galley, 43 gal fresh/43 gal waste, fold up transom doors, and integrated speakers.
- 416 gallon fuel capacity supports extended poker run stages and long day cruising ranges.
- Multiple Mercury Racing outboards result in higher routine service and operating costs compared with lower output setups.
- The premium finish can make owners reluctant to haul messy catches aboard, reducing its appeal for hardcore anglers.
- Long term reliability patterns are still evolving, with early commentary largely positive and no widespread failure reports.

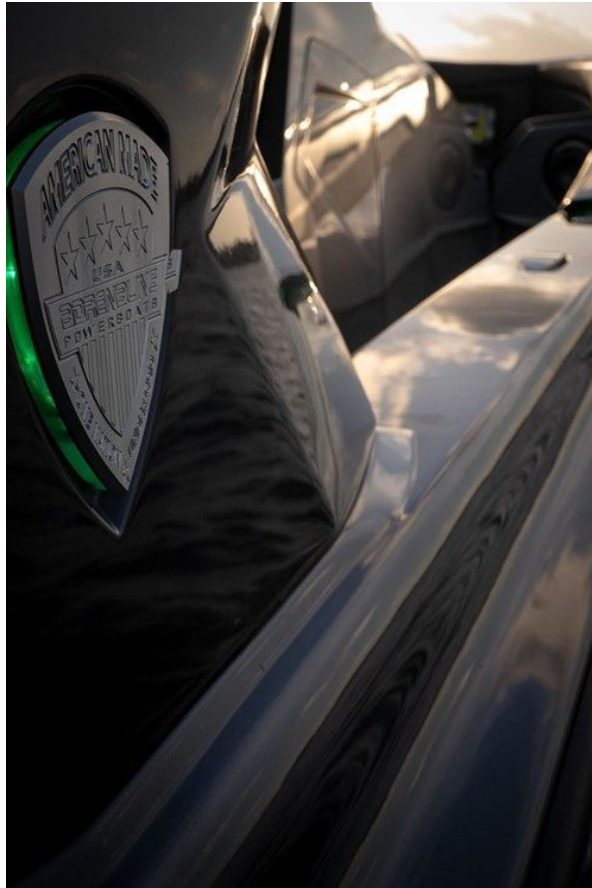

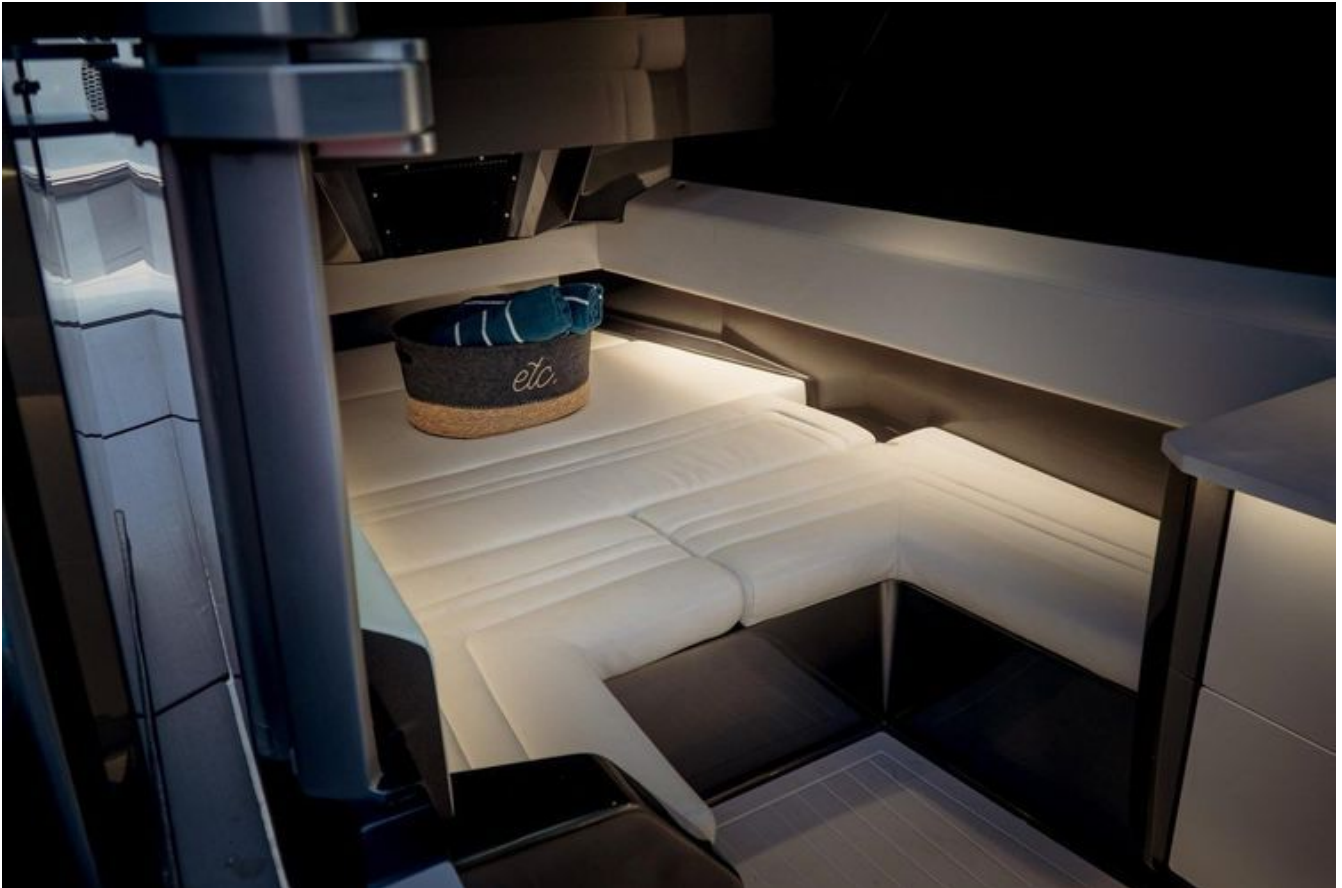
