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OVERVIEW

Discover the AY 60 from ADVENTURE YACHTS—a motor-driven catamaran built on a fiberglass and plastic hull. This model is offered through Shestakov Yacht Sales with brokerage handled by Andrey Shestakov.

Selecting an AY 60

Opting for the AY 60 is sensible if you seek catamaran stability and interior volume combined with the handling and layout of a motor yacht. Propulsion comes from twin **COX Diesel Outboard** units using **Diesel**, giving reliable and uncomplicated operation. A 27 ft (8.47 m) beam delivers spacious living areas and sleeping arrangements for as many as 8 guests, while the Composite deck and fiberglass and plastic hull emphasize longevity and strength.

Owner Experience Review

Marketed by ADVENTURE YACHTS, the AY 60 is pitched at families and liveaboard owners, with options for four-cabin plans or owner-focused three-cabin layouts. Listings and promotional material highlight its suitability for day outings, week-long charters, and extended island cruises, with the yard quoting multi-thousand-mile range capability at an 8-knot economy speed. Published performance estimates place typical cruising around 14–16 knots, sprint capability near 18–22 knots, and a range-optimizing passage speed of about 8 knots; the relatively light ~18.5-ton displacement and narrow hull sections are presented as contributors to reduced drag and improved fuel economy.

Life aboard emphasizes adaptable volume and comfort while at anchor. Early reports describe a choice between four cabins (sleeping eight) or an alternative three-cabin owner configuration featuring a full-hull master, complemented by a spacious saloon and a galley arranged around a central island. A forward beach club with an electrically operated staircase, large toy-storage capacity, and options such as a seapool and hydraulic platforms reinforce the model's "private resort" intent, while significant solar generation (builder-stated 8–8.4 kW) and a substantial battery bank (~164 kWh) are specified to support quieter, near-silent anchoring.

Ownership implications are still emerging: the AY 60 is a brand-new model that debuted in spring 2026, and as of July 9, 2026 there are no independently published long-term owner reports. The choice between diesel outboards or a

hybrid propulsion package affects maintenance profiles—outboards can ease remote servicing, whereas hybrid and battery systems add electrical upkeep and battery lifecycle planning. ADVENTURE YACHTS also advertises charter-management and maintenance programs, along with a seven-year refit proposal, for owners who wish the yard to oversee upkeep during charter operations.

Pros and Cons

- Flexible accommodation plans—either four cabins or a three-cabin owner’s suite—make it well suited to family cruising and charter operations.
- Builder-claimed transoceanic capability of approximately 2,800–3,000 nm at 8 kn supports long-distance voyages.
- A forward beach club and a large solar array (~8–8.4 kW) paired with roughly 164 kWh of battery storage improve comfort and reduce noise while anchored.
- Extremely new model with no independent long-term owner feedback available as of July 9, 2026.
- Hybrid propulsion and battery installations introduce added electrical maintenance and battery lifecycle considerations.
- Many quoted speed and range figures come from manufacturer claims or press releases rather than broad owner verification.

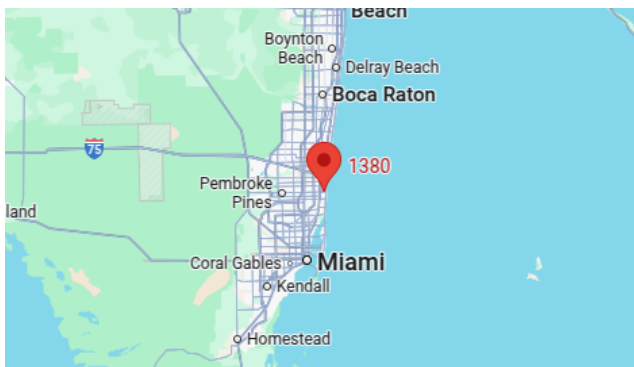
