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OVERVIEW

Presented by Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales, the Aicon Yachts 85 is a high end motor yacht built on a fiberglass-and-plastic hull, offering spacious living areas and systems suited to extended cruising.

Selecting a 85

Select the 85 when you want a polished motor-yacht platform designed for long range comfort. Measuring 86 ft (26.49 m) LOA with a 21 ft (6.43 m) beam, it supplies ample volume for up to 10 guests, complemented by 6 heads and 2 crew cabins. Twin CAT inboard diesels and a Deep Vee hull form give surefooted handling, while the fiberglass deck and fiberglass-and-plastic hull deliver a durable, low maintenance structure.

Features of the Model

- Twin CAT inboard diesel engines deliver dependable propulsion for the 85.
- Deep Vee hull form for steady handling and favorable seakeeping.
- Sturdy fiberglass-and-plastic hull with a Fiberglass deck for simplified upkeep.
- Accommodation for as many as 10 guests, supported by 6 heads and 2 crew cabins to enable professional service aboard.
- Substantial fuel (2,325 gal) and fresh water (528 gal) tanks that extend time on passage.

Q: What type of yacht is the Aicon Yachts 85? A: It is a luxury motor yacht constructed on a fiberglass-and-plastic hull designed for durability and straightforward maintenance.

Q: How many people can the yacht accommodate? A: The layout is set up to host up to **10 guests**, with **6 heads** and **2 crew cabins** to ensure professional

onboard service.

Q: What powers the yacht? A: Propulsion comes from two **CAT** engines, installed **Inboard** , running on **Diesel** .

Q: What are the key dimensions? A: The vessel's **LOA** is 86 ft (26.49 m) and the **beam** measures 21 ft (6.43 m), offering generous interior volume.

Q: What is the hull design? A: It employs a **Deep Vee** hull configuration combined with a fiberglass-and-plastic hull and a Fiberglass deck for structural integrity and efficient upkeep.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and professional crews rate the 85 by Aicon Yachts as a multi role yacht well suited to family cruising, charter operations, and lively weekend entertaining. The four cabin arrangement—with a full beam master—accommodates comfortable overnight stays, while the flybridge is a focal point for socializing, featuring a 4 person Jacuzzi. Sales brochures and broker walk throughs consistently highlight a spacious galley, a natural flow from salon to dining area, and roomy guest staterooms; many used boats have received interior refits or upgrades, and some reviewers liken the salon finish to that of a good four star hotel.

On trial runs, owners typically report a cruising speed near 27 knots with a maximum speed around 30 knots. The hull's 13° transom deadrise supports efficient planing and strong drive performance. A number of owners have observed a tendency to run bow high; online discussions document corrective approaches such as adjusting tabs or interceptors, and re setting misaligned trim tabs, after which handling improves.

Maintenance perspectives are practical: engine room accessibility is rated good, with approximately 6'6" to 7' of overhead and walk around clearance for

the twin Cat C32s. Common items on used boat checklists include main engine servicing (heat exchanger work among them), generator overhauls, trim tab system replacement, thruster motor swaps, and seacock/hose renewals. Owner forums often recommend routine trim/tab alignment checks to maintain the proper running attitude.

Pros and Cons

- Four cabin layout with a full beam master provides comfortable family cruising and overnight capability.
- Expansive flybridge with a 4 person Jacuzzi and multiple social areas is ideal for private use or charter.
- Typical cruise around 27 knots (approximately 30 knots top) with effective planing and a 13° transom deadrise.
- Some boats exhibit a bow high running attitude that can require trim tab or interceptor adjustment.
- Trim/tab alignment is a known corrective maintenance task for this model.
- Common used boat maintenance items can include major servicing such as heat exchanger work, generator overhauls, thruster motor replacement, and seacock/hose renewals.

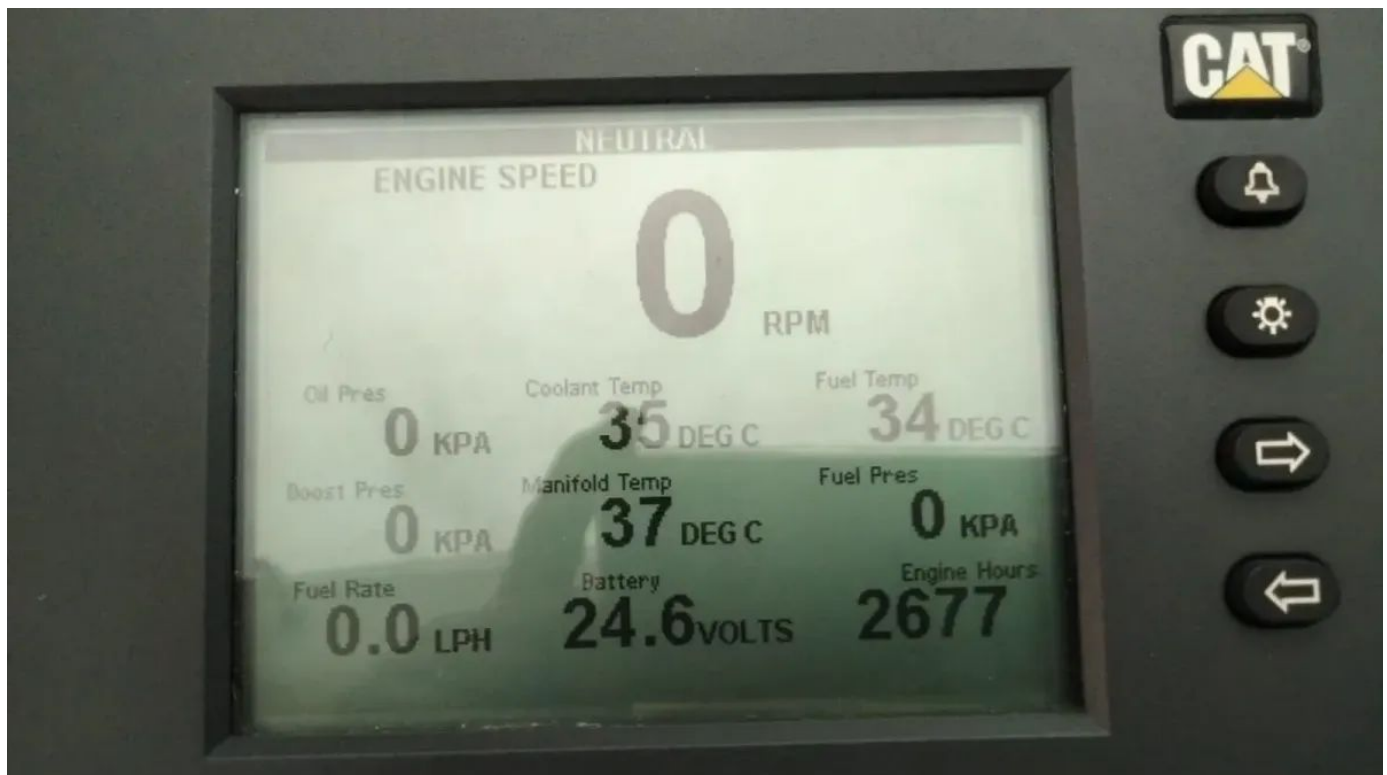
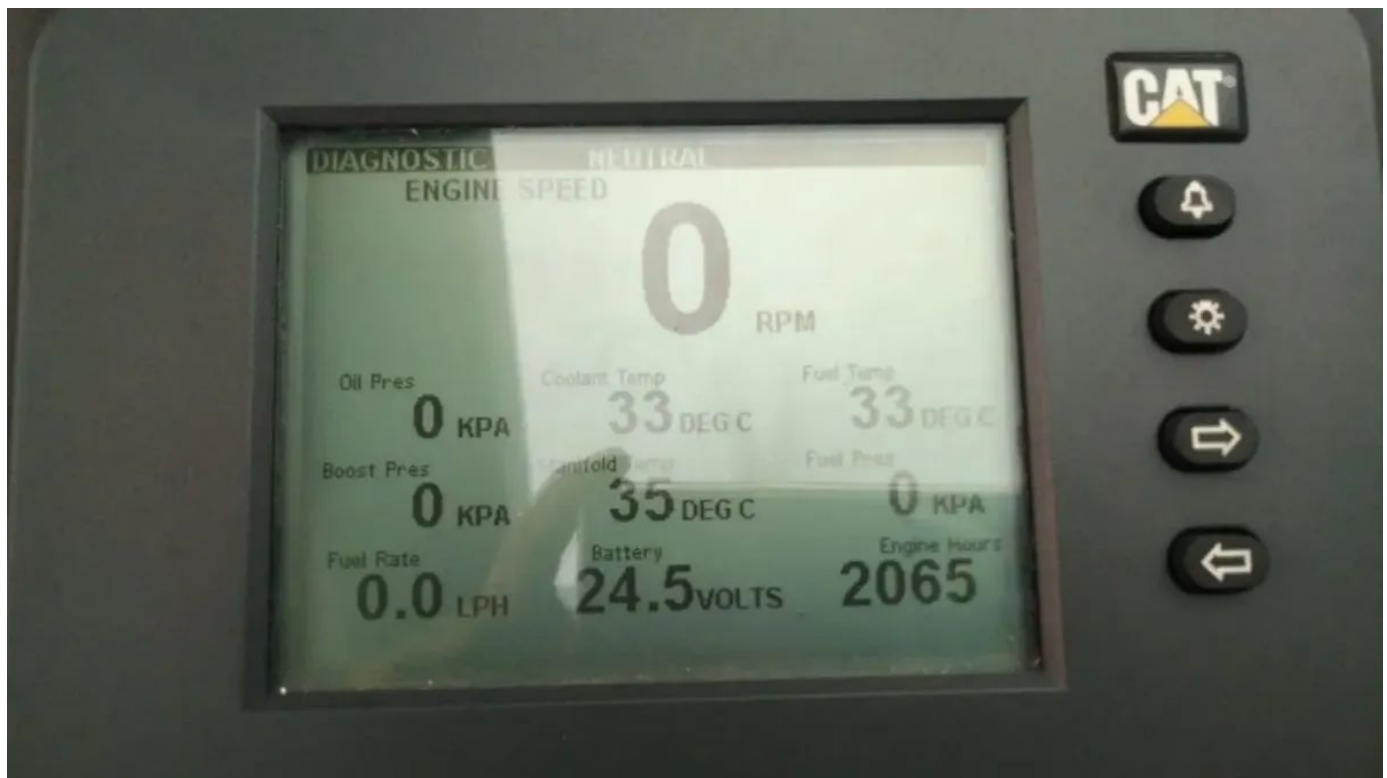
