The ALFAMARINE 60 is a showcase of Italian naval architecture where performance and flair converge, offering brisk acceleration and surefooted handling for discerning owners. Presented by Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales, this motor yacht distinguishes itself in the motor yachts segment through its fiberglass and plastic hull construction and comfortable sleeping arrangements for up to 6 guests.

Opting for the 60 signals a priority on dynamic performance and elegant lines. Powered by twin MTU inboard diesels and built on a fiberglass and plastic construction platform, it appeals to buyers seeking a lively helm, efficient cruising around 30 knots, and an exhilarating top speed reaching 45 knots. Q: What kind of yacht is the 60? A: It is a motor yacht listed in the motor yachts market and constructed on a fiberglass and plastic hull foundation.

Q: What are the performance figures? A: The ALFAMARINE 60 cruises at a

cruising speed of 30 kn (34.52 mph) and attains a **maximum speed** of 45 kn (51.78 mph).

Q: What engines power the yacht? A: It features **twin MTU inboard diesel** engines, offering responsive throttle control and efficient passage-making.

Q: How many people can sleep onboard? A: The yacht provides **accommodations for 6** and **sleeps 6** , making it well suited for brisk weekend trips.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and commercial charter operators commonly describe the 60 by ALFAMARINE as a rapid, owner-friendly platform ideal for day trips and short coastal transfers, often cited for routes such as Amalfi–Capri. The three-cabin arrangement comfortably accommodates family weekends for up to six guests, while the expansive cockpit with generous fore and aft sunpads is tailored to sightseeing, al fresco dining, and relaxed cruising.

On the water, reviews note a lively, responsive helm with minimal vibration and low noise levels; the deep V hull is reported to slice through waves with a gentle entry when handled correctly. In HT configurations equipped with MAN engines and Arneson surface drives, owners and trial reports have recorded peak speeds beyond 48 knots and normal cruising in the 33–35 knot range, though actual performance depends on engine choice and specific setup.

Practical considerations include an accessible, well-arranged engine room that simplifies routine checks. Many pre-owned listings reference comprehensive refits or engine overhauls over time, and at least one owner has highlighted

the need for paint attention on hull and superstructure. Surface drives require adherence to manufacturer maintenance schedules but are appreciated for having fewer submerged components compared with conventional propulsion gear.

Pros and Cons

- Reported top speeds over 48 knots in HT configurations with MAN engines and Arneson surface drives, with typical cruise around 33–35 knots.
- Deep V hull delivers soft impacts in chop with a responsive helm and low vibration/noise.
- Three double cabins with three ensuites plus a crew cabin, and a large cockpit with fore/aft sunpads suit day charter and family weekends.
- The deep V design demands substantial power to perform as intended.
- Many used examples show refits/engine overhauls, and owners note paint attention on hull and superstructure.
- Arneson surface drives require adherence to manufacturer maintenance schedules despite their efficient, low parts underwater profile.

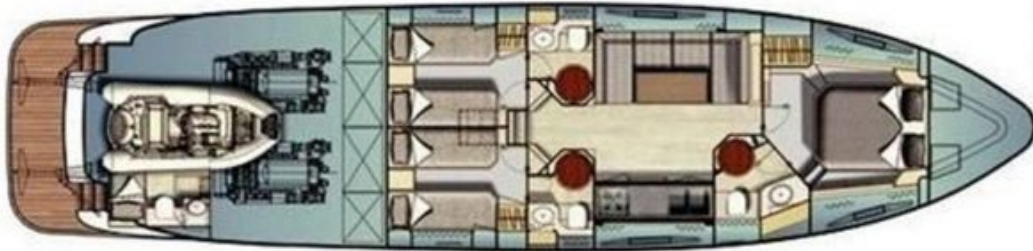
