OVERVIEW

The 18 open electric from ALFASTREET MARINE is categorized among motor yachts and rides on a hull listed in the fiberglass and plastic category. Offered through Shestakov Yacht Sales with broker Andrey Shestakov, it combines compact proportions and uncomplicated systems for easygoing time afloat.

Selecting a 18 open electric

Opt for the 18 open electric when you want a small-footprint motor yacht that is easy to operate and well-suited to sheltered waters. With a 19 ft (5.8 m) overall length and a minimum draft of 1.312 ft (0.4 m), it's tailored for shallow bays and calm harbors, while the single outboard propulsion keeps ownership simple. - Capable of operating in shallow water thanks to a 1.312 ft (0.4 m) minimum draft.
- Easy ownership and straightforward handling provided by a single outboard engine.
- Robust hull constructed in the fiberglass and plastic class paired with a Fiberglass deck.
- Small overall footprint at 19 ft (5.8 m) that simplifies mooring and storage.
- Manufactured by ALFASTREET MARINE within the motor yachts segment.

Owner Experience Review

In everyday use the 18 open electric by ALFASTREET MARINE excels as a relaxed family day-boat for lakes, harbors, and other protected areas (CE category D). The electric drive is optimized for quiet sightseeing and slow cruising; battery banks in the neighborhood of 10–20 kWh provide very extended range when maintaining an easy pace of about 5 km/h. The cockpit layout favors social interaction, with a central helm, perimeter seating, a compact table/bar arrangement, storage beneath seats, and accommodation for up to 8 people; options include Seadeck surface coverings, UV resistant upholstery, and an optional small swim platform.

Underway the boat is notably quiet and steady at low speeds, featuring a displacement/slow speed hull designed for calm-water comfort rather than offshore passage-making. Available deck and roof enhancements—such as an optional hydraulic hardtop—offer protection and improve comfort in light chop, but this model is not intended as a blue water platform; demonstrations typically emphasize leisurely cruising over high-speed capability. Ownership attention centers on the electric propulsion system: a standard onboard charger of roughly 1 kW and accessible battery installation points are part of the package, and long-term costs are principally driven by battery servicing or eventual replacement, which generally requires qualified marine electrical technicians. Comprehensive long-term owner testimonies are limited, so most available information is drawn from dealer specifications and expert commentary.

Pros and Cons

- Whisper quiet operation with zero local emissions makes it well suited to marinas, rental fleets, and areas restricting petrol/diesel engines.
- Social day boat arrangement featuring a central helm and perimeter seating

for up to 8, plus useful storage and finish options.

- Optional hydraulic hardtop adds shelter and comfort in light chop on protected waters.
- Intended for protected waters (CE D) and not engineered for rough or open sea passages.
- Displacement/slow speed hull and modest top speed favor relaxed cruising rather than rapid transits.
- Battery maintenance and eventual replacement are the main long term expense and usually require skilled marine electrical service.

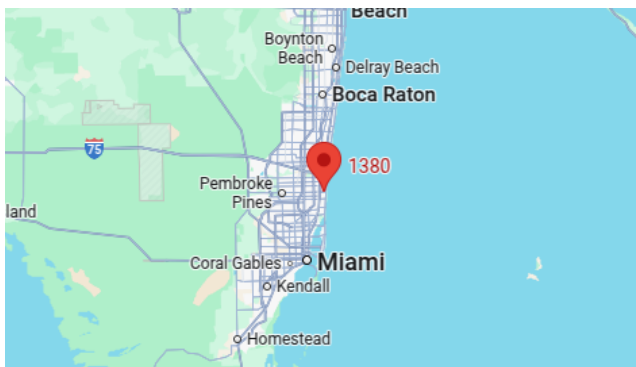
