Q: What type of yacht is the 25 Cabin Evolution? A: It is a motor yacht manufactured by ALFASTREET MARINE with a fiberglass and plastic hull. Key descriptors such as **type** , **builder** , and **hull** capture its primary characteristics.

Q: What are the key dimensions of the model? A: The vessel measures **27 ft (8.4 m)** LOA, has a **7 ft (2.4 m)** beam, and a **1.64 ft (0.5 m)** minimum draft, giving it a compact footprint suitable for near shore cruising.

Owner Experience Review

The 25 Cabin Evolution from ALFASTREET MARINE is intended primarily as a near shore dayboat for family outings and social cruising, built to CE Category C standards and introduced into production in 2021. It offers seating for up to eight people, and its deep, protective cockpit with relatively high bulwarks provides a drier, more sheltered feel in moderate chop; two hull-mounted trim flaps assist in refining trim and enhancing control.

Aboard, the social-focused cockpit — featuring two facing three seat benches, a modular galley module, and an extendable sunbed of approximately 1.7 m — is widely noted as well appointed for entertaining. The single small cabin (1 cabin/2 berths) is compact with limited access, making it more suitable for short rests or simple overnighting rather than extended liveaboard comfort. When the boat is fully occupied with eight guests, movement around the deck can become constrained, so it functions best as a relaxed entertaining platform rather than a vessel for continuous circulation. Public long term owner feedback is limited, so much assessment derives from sea trials and published specs. The model's patented hydraulic hard top closes in roughly 30 seconds and, as with any mechanical system, should be part of a focused inspection. The boat is offered with outboard and alternative inboard/electric/hybrid driveline choices; outboard configurations follow

typical outboard service routines.

Pros and Cons

- Deep, high sided cockpit creates a drier, more protected feel in light chop.
- Social cockpit layout — two facing 3 seater benches, a modular galley, and an ≈1.7 m sunbed — is well equipped for entertaining.
- Twin trim flaps on the hull aid in trimming the boat and improving control.
- The small single cabin, with tight access, limits comfort for extended stays.
- With eight people aboard, deck movement becomes restricted, reducing circulation.
- CE Category C design emphasizes near shore use rather than offshore passagemaking.
