Discover the 25 Cabin from ALFASTREET MARINE — a compact, well-appointed motor yacht built on a time-tested steel hull. Its efficient single-engine layout, thoughtfully arranged interior, and cozy two-person sleeping arrangement make it an excellent option for tranquil coastal and inland cruising.

Selecting a 25 Cabin

Opting for the 25 Cabin signals a preference for uncomplicated ownership, nimble handling, and practical onboard comfort. At 27 ft (8.38 m) LOA and an 8 ft (2.49 m) beam it's easy to handle, and the shallow draft of 1.64–2.559 ft (0.5–0.78 m) lets you explore anchorages off the beaten path. Powered by a single Mercury engine, it cruises smoothly at 7 kn and can reach up to 12 kn, delivering peaceful passages and straightforward maintenance. Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the 25 Cabin? A: It is a compact **motor yacht** built on a sturdy **steel hull** platform, well suited to relaxed cruising.

Q: What are the **speeds** of the 25 Cabin? A: Typical performance is a **cruising speed** of 7 kn (8.06 mph) and a **maximum speed** of 12 kn (13.81 mph).

Q: How many people can it **sleep** ? A: The layout provides **accommodations for 2** , **sleeps 2** , and includes **1 head** for comfortable short-stay cruising.

Q: Who is the **builder and designer** of this model? A: ALFASTREET MARINE serves as the **builder** , **hull designer** , and **interior designer** , with propulsion handled by a single Mercury engine.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and operators most often deploy the 25 Cabin from ALFASTREET MARINE as a flexible dayboat; many units are used or chartered with 6–8 guests on inland lakes and throughout the Mediterranean. The design places strong emphasis on the cockpit — it occupies much of the vessel’s length and serves as the primary social hub, making time on deck the central experience. The compact cabin offers privacy and short-term sleeping options, though access can be tight and interior volume is limited, so it performs best as a weekender rather than a full-time cruiser. Its frequent use in charters and media coverage highlights its accessibility and broad market appeal.

On the water, owners and reviewers note a refined, sporty boat feel with good

stability for its size, and the vessel's handling character varies with propulsion choice. The model is available with outboard, inboard, hybrid, and electric drivetrains, and optional hull flaps are offered to fine-tune seakeeping, so prospective buyers should sea-trial the exact configuration they plan to buy. Routine service items include maintenance of the hydraulic hard-top — praised for its responsiveness and clever design but still a mechanical system requiring upkeep — as well as the usual outboard/inboard care for Yamaha or Mercury powerplants. As a smaller boutique builder, ALFASTREET MARINE typically sells through dealer partners, so confirming local service support is a recommended part of pre-purchase due diligence. Public long-term owner testimony is limited, but these observations are consistent across press reviews and charter operator feedback.

Pros and Cons

- The cockpit-first arrangement creates a generous, well-equipped social space optimized for day use.
- Reviewers report a refined, stable sportsboat demeanor relative to its size.
- Multiple propulsion choices (outboard, inboard, hybrid, electric) plus available hull flaps let owners tailor handling.
- The cabin is compact and access is somewhat awkward, making it better suited to short overnights.
- The foredeck and forward side decks are narrower than the cockpit, restricting forward deck space.
- The hydraulic hard-top is an appealing feature but adds a system that will require periodic maintenance.
