OVERVIEW

The 28 open motor from ALFASTREET MARINE is a compact and adaptable motor yacht built on a fiberglass and plastic hull with a Fiberglass deck. Measuring 32 ft (9.79 m) LOA with a 9 ft (2.99 m) beam and a shallow 2.461 ft (0.75 m) draft, and driven by a single Outboard engine, it's designed for efficient short-range cruising and easy handling. Owner Experience Review

Owners and charter operators typically deploy the 28 open motor by ALFASTREET MARINE for daytime cruising, social outings, and easy coastal passages. Listings for day charters, including offerings in Ibiza with a skipper, highlight its popularity as a convivial “party cruiser.” Feedback from real listings and owners applauds the roof arrangement, compact cabin, and a well-thought deck layout featuring a large aft lounge and an ample swim platform; examples exist in both open and cabin configurations, often with an optional hydraulic hardtop.

Practical listings frequently specify 1 cabin, 1 bathroom, 2 berths, and capacity for roughly 11 guests, underscoring its role as a day-boat rather than a long-range cruiser. Online discussions focus largely on propulsion and planing behavior rather than chronic defects: owners and prospective buyers ask about top speeds and whether 220 HP delivers satisfactory performance, and some describe the on-water character as “pontoon meets center console,” suggesting a broad, stable feel that many recommend testing firsthand. Because comprehensive owner-supplied performance figures are sparse, most advice points to conducting a full sea trial and reviewing service history, engine logs, battery condition, and bilge systems; forum threads do not reveal any consistent pattern of mechanical failure.

Pros and Cons

- Social dayboat layout with a large aft lounge, sunpad, and a substantial swim step favored in forums and charter listings.

- Available in Open or Cabin layouts, with the option of a hydraulic hardtop for added shelter and convenience.
- Suited to day-charter operations (for example, Ibiza listings with a skipper), with typical specs of 1 cabin, 1 bathroom, 2 berths, and capacity around 11 guests.
- Numerous forum queries about speed and planing—notably whether 220 HP is sufficient—mean actual performance should be confirmed on a sea trial.
- Handling is often characterized as “pontoon meets center console,” a broad beam stability profile prospective buyers should evaluate in person.
- Publicly shared long term ownership data is limited, so purchasers should depend on detailed service records and standard pre purchase inspections.
