Owner Experience Review

Owners typically use the 20 by AQUASPORT for inshore and nearshore activities—fishing in bays, cruising inlets, and navigating backwaters—alongside trailerable day trips to beaches and local ramps. Models fitted with a small cuddy are reported to be modest but functional for brief overnight stays or extended day excursions, whereas the center console variants are frequently chosen for regular local fishing; as one owner put it, “he takes that thing everywhere.”

On the water, some owners note a firmer ride in choppy conditions, while the deeper V/CCP versions of the 20-foot AQUASPORT hull—owners reference roughly 20° deadrise on some examples—offer superior tracking and handling when the sea opens up. Users describe a satisfactory cruising feel with commendable fuel economy for the size, but ergonomics often reflect older 20-foot designs: a basic console, narrow walkthroughs, and limited storage. Age-related interior wear can appear on older boats, including soft or rotten cockpit and floor areas. Prospective buyers should set realistic maintenance expectations: many older models carried Johnson/Evinrude engines that have required rebuilds or full repowers, and common owner projects include replacing water pumps, trim/tilt units, fuel lines or tanks, and repairing floors or transoms, with parts availability and support varying by legacy year.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile platform for inshore and nearshore fishing, beach trips, and trailerable dayboating.
- Small cuddy configurations can support short weekend or day excursions

despite constrained space.

- Pleasant cruising characteristics with notably good fuel efficiency for a 20 footer.
- Some boats can be uncomfortable in chop, particularly compared with deeper V/CCP variants.
- Age-related interior and structural deterioration is common, including soft or rotten cockpit/floor sections.
- Older outboards frequently demand significant maintenance or repower work, and parts/support can be inconsistent.

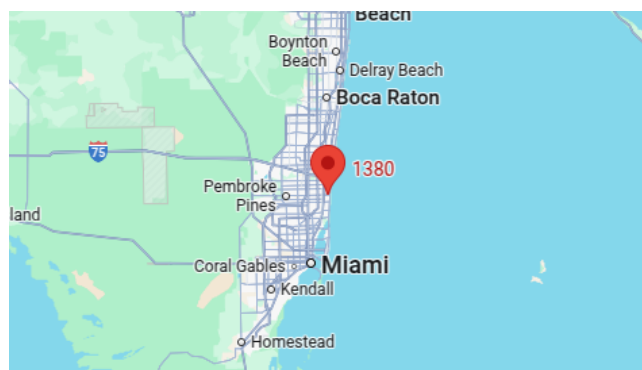
