## OVERVIEW

---

Boca Bay 244 by AQUASPORT is a compact motor yacht built on a fiberglass and plastic hull with a fiberglass deck, offered through Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales.

## Selecting a Boca Bay 244

---

Opt for the Boca Bay 244 when you want a nimble 24 ft (7.47 m) craft with an 8 ft (2.59 m) beam, a single Suzuki outboard running on gas for uncomplicated maintenance, an 80 gallon fuel tank for extended days on the water, and the convenience of 1 head aboard a stable monohull. - 1 head to provide basic onboard sanitation.

Q: What are the dimensions of the Boca Bay 244? A: The vessel's **LOA** measures 24 ft (7.47 m) and its **beam** is 8 ft (2.59 m).

Q: What powers the boat? A: The propulsion is a single Suzuki **outboard** , and the fuel type specified is Gas.

Q: What is the draft range? A: The listed **draft** spans from 3.281 ft to 3.827 ft (1 m to 1.1666 m).

Q: What are the fuel capacity and onboard facilities? A: The **fuel capacity** is 80 gal, and the boat includes **1 head** for onboard convenience.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners typically place the Boca Bay 244 from AQUASPORT squarely in the bay boat category: it excels on inshore flats, around tarpon lanes, and at sandbar gatherings. Many owners outfit their boats with shallow water anchors and electric trolling motors—Power Pole systems and Minn Kota units are common—to enable stealthy approaches and rapid, secure stake outs. As a trailerable nearshore day boat (dry weight roughly 2,850 lb), it's pitched at family day cruising as well as fishing trips; marketplace listings often mention a Suzuki DF200 as a popular, sufficiently powerful engine choice.

Feedback from owners and sales listings is consistent: the hull performs well in sheltered bays and channels but is not designed for extended offshore passages. A handful of owners have reported a port side list when trim tabs are fully retracted; this tendency is generally corrected by applying tab adjustments and mindful load distribution. The onboard layout prioritizes daytime comfort—the 8'–8.6' beam range provides usable casting room and seating, while the small cuddy and single head offer only basic overnight capability. Practical maintenance advice from forums and listings emphasizes checking fishbox and bilge drains and pump setups; on older models, inspect floors, the transom, and the fuel tank condition. As with any used outboard package, confirm engine hours and maintenance records—some listings note recent OEM powerhead work. These observations are drawn from owner reports and sale postings, so individual experiences may differ.

## Pros and Cons

- Trailerable weight around 2,850 lb keeps towing and storage manageable.
- Bay boat characteristics make it ideal for protected waters, flats, and relaxed sandbar outings.
- Typical equipment packages like Power Pole and Minn Kota simplify shallow water fishing.
- Not suited for heavy offshore conditions; best used nearshore and in bays.
- Reports of a port list with trim tabs retracted may require corrective tab input and load adjustment.
- Limited overnight amenities—a compact cuddy and a single head—constrain longer stays aboard.
