Experience the versatility and balance of the 2026 Aquila 46 Yacht Power Catamaran by Aquila Power Catamarans — a contemporary motor yacht and nimble catamaran built with a fiberglass construction hull and composite deck. Represented by Andrey Shestakov of Shestakov Yacht Sales, this 47 foot power catamaran combines a wide 23 foot beam with efficient twin inboard diesel propulsion to give confident coastal performance and longer stays afloat.

## Selecting a 2026 Aquila 46 Yacht Power Catamaran

---

When your priority is a roomy, stable multihull that maximizes interior volume and uses proven twin diesel systems, the 2026 Aquila 46 Yacht Power Catamaran is a compelling choice. The broad 23 ft (7.1 m) beam and modest 4.068 ft (1.24 m) draft provide comfortable seakeeping and the ability to explore shallower anchorages, while a pair of inboard Volvo Penta diesel engines supply reliable thrust and precise handling.

## Features of the Model

- Twin inboard diesel propulsion: 2 x Volvo Penta for dependable handling and efficiency.
- Stable multihull design: the catamaran configuration enhances comfort under way and at anchor.
- Durable construction: fiberglass hull with composite deck.
- Shallow draft: approximately 4.068 ft (1.24 m) for flexible cruising in coastal waters.
- Practical capacities: 475.51 gallons of fuel and 211.34 gallons of fresh water help extend your time between stops.

## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What are the key dimensions of the model? A: The 2026 Aquila 46 Yacht Power Catamaran measures an **LOA** of 47 ft (14.36 m) and offers a **beam** of 23 ft (7.1 m), providing abundant interior volume and enhanced stability for family and extended cruising.

Q: How shallow can it go, and is it suitable for coastal cruising? A: With an **approximate draft** of 4.068 ft (1.24 m), this catamaran is well configured for

coastal passages and island hopping where shallower anchorages are important.

Q: What engines power this yacht, and what fuel does it use? A: It is powered by **2 inboard Volvo Penta** engines that run on **diesel**, giving dependable propulsion and widely available service options.

Q: What is the hull and deck made of? A: The hull uses **fiberglass** construction while the deck is built in **composite** for strength and reduced maintenance.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners and reviewers stepping aboard the 2026 Aquila 46 Yacht Power Catamaran commonly report that the design “works well as an owner run package,” making it suited to family cruising and weekend getaways. The Aquila lineage—earlier 44 foot examples that have completed the Great Loop—sets customer expectations for capable long distance cruising on the 46. Layout flexibility, including optional 4–5 cabin plans and convertible owner/charter configurations, expands its utility, while features such as a generous cockpit, flybridge, bow lounge and a salon/galley flow into the cockpit enhance onboard entertaining and daily ease.

On the water, the wide catamaran stance produces a very stable platform with minimal roll in fast turns and an overall composed, comfortable motion. Independent testing recorded 0–10 kt in roughly 5.4 seconds and 0–20 kt in about 18.3 seconds, with an efficient cruise near 14.8 kt that yields an estimated ~215 nm range and a top reported speed around 20.6 kt when fitted

with twin Volvo Penta D6 480s. Owners fitting the optional Hydro Glide® foil—paired with D6 480 or Yanmar 550 installations—have noted reduced pitch/slap and improved fuel economy once speeds exceed roughly 19–21 kt.

Routine maintenance is simplified by excellent engine room access through large aft hatches, full height compartments, clearly labeled systems, and easy reach to the generator and filters. Owner forums discussing Volvo's D series mention some early installation issues (ECU remaps and occasional injector/fuel system attention) and caution that Volvo parts and service can be expensive; as a result, many owners budget conservatively—commonly around 8–10% of the boat's value annually—with D6/drive maintenance scheduled as alternating major and minor intervals. Taken together, the 46 delivers large boat living spaces with serviceability features that benefit owner operators.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Works well as an owner run package with optional 4–5 cabin layouts for private use or charter.
- Very stable platform with little lean in turns and a sedate, comfortable ride.
- Engine room access is excellent with large hatches, full height spaces, and labeled systems for easier service.
- Published best cruise range is about 215 nm at ~14.8 kt, so longer legs require careful planning.
- Reported Hydro Glide® benefits are tied to higher power engines (D6 480 or Yanmar 550) and speeds above roughly 19–21 kt.
- Forum reports cite early D series teething (ECU/injector/fuel system issues) and note that Volvo parts/service can be costly.

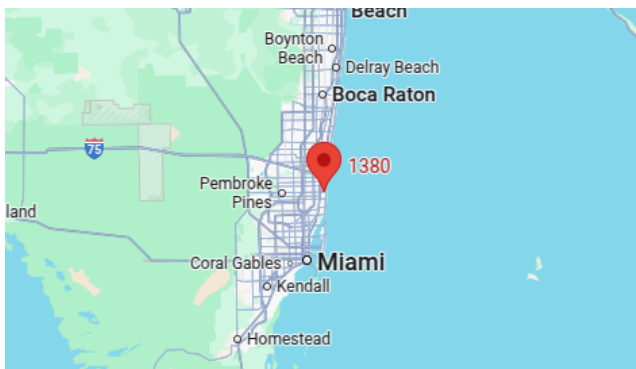
