OVERVIEW

Crafted by ARES CUSTOM YACHTS, the Ares Marine Tri-Deck is a purpose-built tri-deck motor yacht built on an aluminum hull and positioned within the larger motor-yachts segment. Shestakov Yacht Sales, with broker Andrey Shestakov, is available to provide full specifications and assist with acquisition planning for this model.

Selecting a Ares Marine Tri-Deck

Opting for the Ares Marine Tri-Deck means choosing a sizable motor yacht built on a sturdy aluminum construction platform. The yacht measures 141 ft (42.98 m) LOA with a 21 ft (6.4 m) beam and a 22.966 ft (7 m) draft, delivering notable presence and seakeeping. Twin CAT diesel inboard powerplants provide a typical cruise of 11 kn (12.66 mph) and a top speed near 17 kn (19.56 mph), while a gross tonnage of 278 reflects substantial internal volume.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the Ares Marine Tri-Deck? A: It's a tri-deck motor yacht marketed inside the wider motor-yachts segment, constructed upon an aluminum hull.

Q: What are the key performance figures? A: The model delivers a **cruise speed** of 11 kn (12.66 mph) and a **max speed** of 17 kn (19.56 mph), driven by twin **CAT Inboard Diesel** engines.

Q: How is accommodation arranged? A: The layout indicates an **accommodation count** of 11, with the yacht **sleeps** 5, includes **heads** 7, and provides **crew cabins** 5 and **crew beds**

Q: What about construction and hull form? A: The vessel is built in aluminum with a **Monohull** hull form, **deck material** Aluminum, and a **gross tonnage** of 278.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and charter guests commonly describe the Ares Marine Tri-Deck by ARES CUSTOM YACHTS as a platform tailored to charter operations in the Caribbean, family cruising, and day-event hosting. Sale listings frequently emphasize a family-oriented layout featuring a full-beam owner's suite on the main deck, a dedicated sky lounge, a sundeck Jacuzzi, multiple alfresco dining zones, and foredeck storage for the tender and jet skis. The onboard water-toy inventory is a standout—jet skis, seabobs, kayaks, a tri-deck waterslide, and an

estimated 30-foot floating pool—while brokers note suitability for day-charter gatherings of up to roughly 18 guests.

On the water, reported handling and performance point to a comfortable cruise generally between 12–16 knots and a top speed around 18 knots, typically propelled by twin Caterpillar C32 engines. Zero-speed stabilizers and numerous guest comments highlight calm, comfortable behavior both at anchor and underway in standard Caribbean sea states, with charter feedback focusing heavily on the toy package and guest comfort rather than fine points of helm handling.

From an owner's due-diligence perspective, the yacht was delivered in 2012 and appears across listings with multiple refits (2018, 2023, and 2024) and significant yard work, including a documented yard period exceeding \$500,000 at Lauderdale Marine Center. Forum discussion has raised questions about the beam-to-length ratio—describing the hull as unusually narrow for its length—and about build origin and registration year, which makes verification of paperwork and ownership history a common step in pre-purchase reviews; the twin C32 powerplants also bring the typical heavy-maintenance expectations associated with large diesel engines.

Pros and Cons

- Proven Caribbean charter platform suited to family use and day events, with listings referencing day operations for up to ~18 guests.
- Family-focused deck arrangement featuring a main-deck owner's suite, sky lounge, sundeck Jacuzzi, and an extensive toy inventory including a tri-deck waterslide and an approximate 30' floating pool.
- Zero-speed stabilizers and guest reports indicate comfortable behavior both at anchor and while underway.
- Forum commenters note the hull is very narrow for the vessel's length and

raise questions over origin/registration year, prompting careful due diligence.

- Multiple refits (2018, 2023, 2024) and a notable yard period costing over \$500,000 suggest ongoing maintenance planning and associated expense.
- Reported 12–16 knot cruising speeds and an approximate 18 knot top speed may not satisfy buyers seeking higher performance.
