OVERVIEW

The 377 Coupe OB from ASTILLEROS ASTONDOA pairs European design cues with outboard propulsion to create a stylish option in the motor yacht market. Built on a fiberglass and plastic hull with a molded fiberglass deck, it aims to deliver nimble handling and practical cruising features. Shestakov Yacht Sales represents the model, with broker Andrey Shestakov available to guide buyers through the process.

Selecting a 377 Coupe OB

If your priority is a compact performance cruiser that marries stylish lines with everyday usability, the 377 Coupe OB deserves consideration. Measuring 37 ft (11.28 m) LOA with an 11 ft (3.5 m) beam, its proportions are well-suited to coastal passages and weekend getaways. Propulsion comes from triple Mercury outboards, providing lively acceleration and a comfortable cruise speed of 28 knots (32.22 mph), with a maximum capability near 36 knots (41.43 mph) when conditions or mood call for pace. As a motor yacht in the wider motor yachts category, it combines contemporary styling with robust materials — a fiberglass and plastic hull and fiberglass deck that simplify upkeep.

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the 377 Coupe OB? A: The vessel is classified as a motor yacht within the broader motor yachts sector and is built on a fiberglass and plastic hull.

Q: What are the key performance numbers? A: The 377 Coupe OB lists a **cruising speed** of 28 kn (32.22 mph) and a **top speed** of 36 kn (41.43 mph).

Q: What engines power this model? A: Power is provided by **3 x Mercury outboard** engines running on **Gas/Petrol**, tuned for responsive handling and brisk acceleration.

Q: What are the principal dimensions? A: The vessel's **LOA** is 37 ft (11.28 m), **beam** is 11 ft (3.5 m), and **max draft** is 8.202 ft (2.5 m).

Q: What are the onboard capacities and amenities? A: Tankage includes **211 gal of fuel** and **52 gal of fresh water**, and the boat is fitted with **1 head** to support comfortable time aboard. Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly deploy the 377 Coupe OB from ASTILLEROS ASTONDOA as a flexible dayboat or a family weekender, and many examples are also used as skippered day-charter boats across the Mediterranean and Atlantic. The two-cabin layout with a stand-up head and separate shower is ideal for short overnighting; the forward V-berth measures roughly 1.83 x 1.60 m and may feel compact for taller sleepers, though a midship berth can be specified as an option. The cockpit is laid out for entertaining, featuring large sunpads and a wetbar with sink, fridge, and induction hob, while the finish levels present

attractively — BOOTE noted the styling draws attention in any marina.

Underway, the deep-V hull (reported deadrise around 21°) handles short chop with composure; a German sea trial even described its motion through waves as "butterweich." Published trial figures using twin Volvo Penta D4-320s recorded an economical cruise near 25.8 knots at 3000 rpm and a top end close to 34.9 knots, underscoring the hull's efficiency. Low-speed control is notably good, particularly with the optional joystick, and testers recorded turning circles of approximately two boat lengths. Maintenance reports are largely favorable, with adequate access for inboard service and simplified upkeep for the outboard arrangement on the 377 Coupe OB. An independent inspection did find missing fire extinguishers, no manual bilge pump, and an undersized engine-room extinguishing system on one example (the importer committed to rectifying these), so prospective buyers should confirm the safety equipment and fit-out during surveys.

Pros and Cons

- Deep V hull (approx. 21°) produces a composed, reassuring ride in short chop according to test reports.
- Cockpit layout favors social day use with wetbar, ample sunpads, and attractive finishes.
- Optional joystick and responsive steering aid in tight maneuvering, with turning circles near two boat lengths.
- Two cabin arrangement is well suited to short overnight trips rather than extended bluewater cruising.
- The forward V berth (about 1.83 x 1.60 m) can feel confined for taller owners.
- An independent test highlighted missing or undersized safety equipment on one boat; buyers should verify full safety fit out.

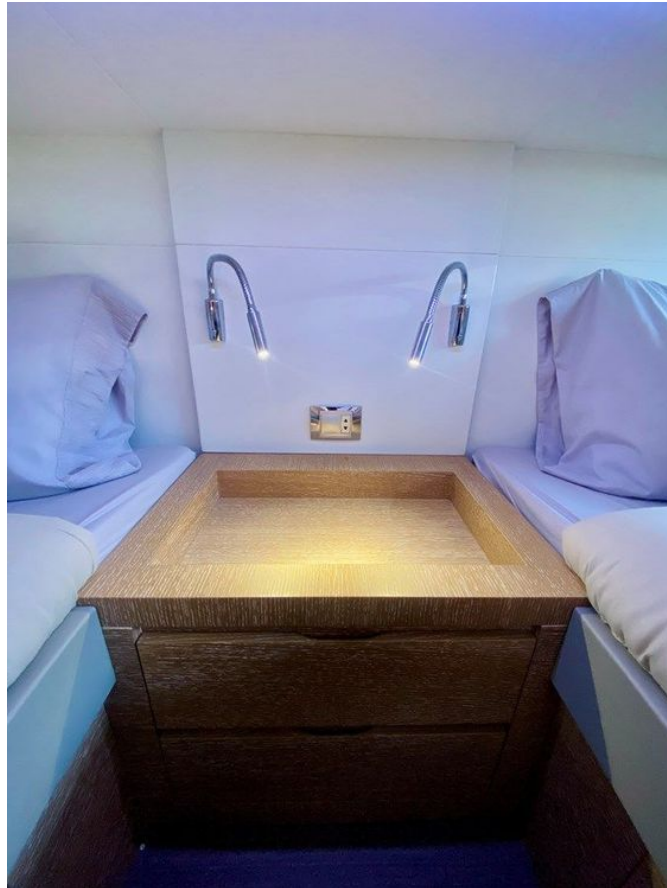
