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OVERVIEW

The 80 GLX by ASTILLEROS ASTONDOA is a sophisticated motor yacht that sits in the higher tier of the motor yachts market. It combines practical onboard capacities with a fiberglass and plastic construction hull and a fiberglass deck. This listing is offered through Shestakov Yacht Sales with brokerage services led by Andrey Shestakov.

Selecting a 80 GLX

Opting for the 80 GLX is a decision driven by the need for a particular balance of size, range, and crewed service areas to suit extended cruising. With an overall length of 81 ft (24.79 m) and a beam of 19 ft (5.97 m), the 80 GLX provides the interior volume desirable for family expeditions or fully crewed operations. Twin inboard MAN diesels make it a practical choice for owners prioritizing reliable power and efficient passagemaking aboard a motor yacht. Features of the Model

- Propulsion: Twin MAN inboard diesel engines supply steady propulsion and predictable handling for both harbor maneuvers and offshore passages.
- Construction: The hull is classed as fiberglass and plastic construction and is mated to a fiberglass deck to offer a compromise between structural integrity, finish, and maintenance ease.
- Capacities: Fuel and water tanks are sizable—1,525 gallons of fuel and 419 gallons of water—enabling extended legs between port calls.
- Accommodation utilities: Five heads are provided for guest convenience, and

two dedicated crew cabins enable professional onboard service.

Owner Experience Review

Owners typically describe the 80 GLX from ASTILLEROS ASTONDOA as a versatile family yacht that remains enjoyable for owner-operated weekend trips, with multiple main-deck configurations—four layout options—that cater to varied owner preferences. The vessel is noted for its strong entertaining credentials: formal dining seating for eight, a spacious salon finished in light oak and Spanish leather, and triple stainless-steel doors that open completely to blend the salon with the teak afterdeck. Some interiors have been adapted for small-scale charter, although the majority of boats discussed in reviews are

privately owned.

Sea trials and press reviews describe a planing V-shaped hull with about a 14° deadrise that gives the yacht a sprightly feel for an 80-foot flybridge model. When fitted with twin MAN 12V engines of roughly 1,550 hp each, reviewers report a cruising speed near 25 knots and a top speed around 33 knots. Feedback emphasizes comfortable performance at cruise speeds, good directional stability, and a hull form optimized for comfort at planing speeds rather than slow-displacement efficiency.

Owners also note some important caveats: forum and owner reports indicate variability in build and finish on certain ASTILLEROS ASTONDOA examples, with gelcoat or finish imperfections in some cases that required corrective work. Boats that are heavily customized or carry significant hotel loads tend to have higher operating and maintenance costs, so proper generator sizing is often stressed as critical. Production years reported for the 80 GLX cluster around 2013–2017, though sources vary.

Pros and Cons

- Sporty planing performance, with an approximate 25 knot cruise and a top speed near ~33 knots, delivering a confident feel at speed.
- Versatile interior planning with four main deck layout choices, including options for open or enclosed galley arrangements.
- Excellent for entertaining: formal dining for eight, an expansive salon, and triple doors that open the salon fully to the afterdeck.
- Reported variability in build quality and finish on some ASTILLEROS ASTONDOA builds, with gelcoat/finish issues that have required remedial attention.
- Potentially higher operating and service costs driven by twin MAN 12V propulsion, substantial hotel loads, and extensive customization — making

correct generator sizing important.

- Hull design favors comfort at planing speeds rather than slow displacement cruising, so it is less suited to trawler style operation.

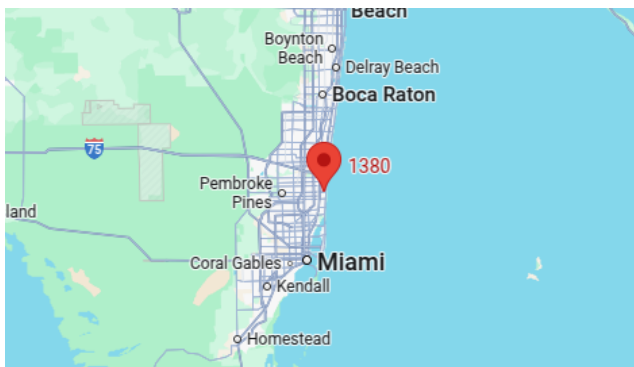
