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OVERVIEW

The AS5 from ASTILLEROS ASTONDOA is a refined luxury motor yacht in the motor yacht segment, constructed on a fiberglass and plastic hull platform and propelled by twin MAN inboard diesel engines. Shestakov Yacht Sales, with broker Andrey Shestakov, provides specialist assistance for this 57 foot vessel, which cruises around 24 knots and can reach up to 32 knots.

- Performance profile: designed to cruise at 24 kn (27.62 mph) with a top speed reaching 32 kn (36.83 mph).

Owner Experience Review

Owners and brokers commonly describe the AS5 from ASTILLEROS ASTONDOA as a true owner operator platform ideal for family cruising, weekend runs, and day outings. Feedback highlights a luminous salon and an easy social flow from the cockpit through the saloon to the flybridge, while a generous beach club extends usable outdoor space. Typical accommodations include a full beam master suite amidships plus two guest cabins (with an optional crew cabin), making the layout well suited to families and occasional light charter. Because the AS5 is semi custom, interior choices and storage solutions vary by hull, so reviewing a boat's specific spec is important; owners and forums also praise the perceived build quality from ASTILLEROS ASTONDOA.

On the water, the AS5 is more about steady, comfortable cruising than outright

sport performance. Sea trials and owner reports generally record mid 20s-knot cruising speeds with top speeds in the low 30s (roughly 32–33 kn), predictable handling, and confident low speed control when equipped with IPS pods and a joystick, even in moderate conditions. Common installed powerplants include Volvo Penta D11 IPS950 or MAN i6 units; while IPS systems improve handling, they also require scheduled pod maintenance and specialist servicing. Routine upkeep is comparable to other 55–60 ft flybridge yachts, and because semi custom system routing can differ between hulls, a thorough survey and review of service history is recommended.

Pros and Cons

- Family oriented layout with a bright salon, strong circulation between cockpit, saloon and flybridge, and a practical beach club.
- Sized for owner operators with predictable handling and effective low speed maneuvering when fitted with an IPS joystick.
- Solid perceived construction quality from ASTILLEROS ASTONDOA with semi custom flexibility for interior personalization.
- Not designed as a high performance race boat; its strengths lie in smooth, comfortable cruising rather than top end speed.
- IPS pod drives bring handling advantages but need scheduled maintenance and occasional specialist service.
- Semi custom builds can vary significantly by hull, so systems and equipment differ and a careful survey of the specific vessel is essential.

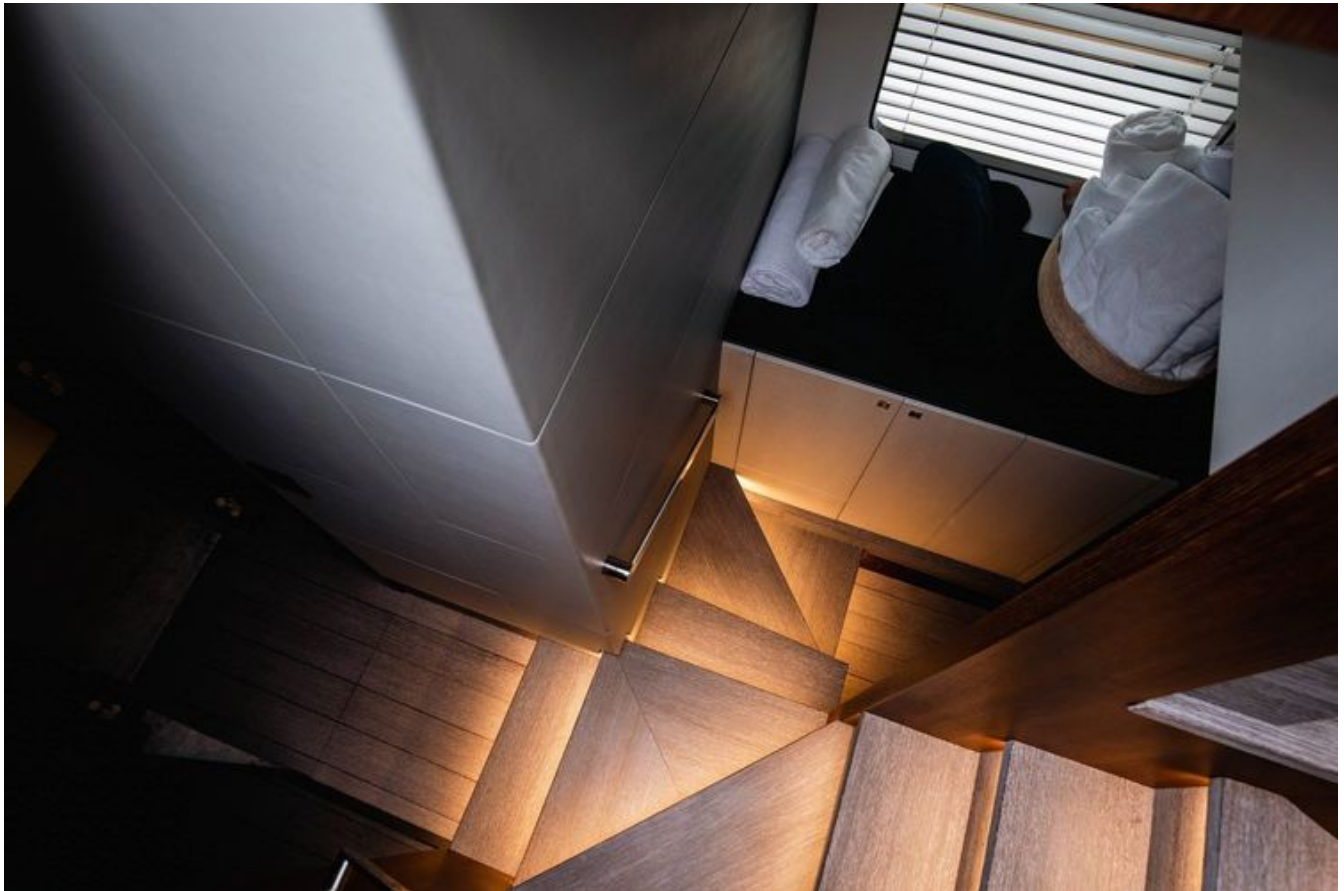

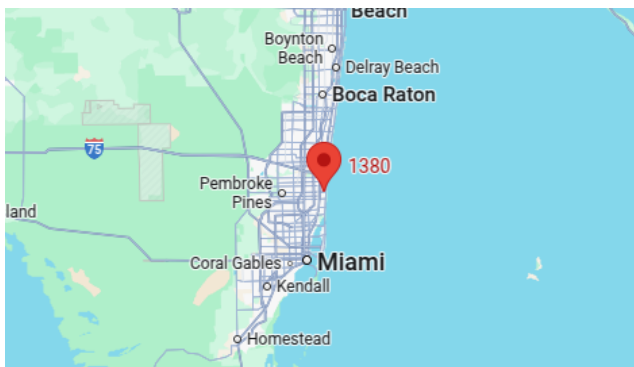
