The 36 from AVANTI MARINE INC marries the straightforwardness of a single Mercury propulsion package with the practicality of a center console layout in a compact motor yacht format. Constructed on a resilient fiberglass/plastic hull and finished with a fiberglass deck, it presents a simple, durable platform for confident days on the water. Prospective owners looking at the 36 will find its 36 ft (10.97 m) overall length easy to handle, enjoy the maintenance simplicity of a single Mercury powerplant, and benefit from the unobstructed movement offered by a center console. If your priorities include a clean, no-nonsense layout built from proven components, this motor yacht is worth detailed consideration.

Q: What is the basic type of the 36? A: It is a motor yacht arranged as a center console, constructed on a fiberglass/plastic hull with a fiberglass deck and an LOA of 36 ft (10.97 m).

Q: Who is the **builder** of this model? A: The 36 is manufactured by AVANTI MARINE INC. For detailed information contact Shestakov Yacht Sales and broker Andrey Shestakov.

Q: What **engine** configuration does it have? A: The model typically comes fitted with a single **Mercury** outboard (1 x Mercury), which simplifies operation and maintenance scheduling.

Q: What are the **materials** used for the hull and deck? A: The hull is

categorized as fiberglass/plastic and the deck is made of fiberglass, chosen for durability and ease of upkeep.

Owner Experience Review

Owners, brokers, and listings commonly portray the 36 from AVANTI MARINE INC as a versatile center console fitted for entertaining, raft ups, fishing trips, and family day cruising. Some listings highlight offshore capability: a 2014 example equipped with twin Mercury Verado 300s reportedly cruises near 40 mph with top speeds exceeding 50 mph. The newer twin stepped deep V hull form is designed to enhance comfort in choppy seas, though actual speed and handling are heavily dependent on the chosen propulsion package, which in the market ranges from single outboards to twin and even triple 300 hp installations.

The design prioritizes day use, but the compact cabin is often described as adequate for occasional overnights—typically accommodating a porta potti, a small nap area for children, and useful storage. The open deck generally includes multiple seating positions, substantial under seat storage, and many listings show upgraded audio systems; boats kept on lifts frequently present with well maintained gelcoat and upholstery, and a number of sales included a trailer, reflecting ownership by trailer or lift. Regarding maintenance, the number of engines increases service complexity and parts costs; maintenance histories are sometimes available in listings, and reviewers did not identify a pattern of recurring faults specific to the 36. One owner comment singled out easy mechanical access and sound installation, and a JD Power observation about earlier Avanti 36 variants notes that exclusive salt water use can

accelerate depreciation—an item to factor into surveys and history reviews.

Pros and Cons

- Flexible center console layout suitable for entertaining, raft ups, fishing, family outings, and short getaways.
- Twin stepped deep V hull intended for offshore use; seller reports indicate about 40 mph cruise and 50+ mph top speed on twin 300s.
- Functional cabin and generous deck space with a porta potti, a nap area, and extensive under seat storage.
- Ride and performance vary significantly with the selected engine package; match expectations to the installed propulsion.
- Twin and triple outboard configurations add to maintenance complexity and increase parts expenditures compared with a single engine setup.
- Limited concentrated owner failure data; review maintenance records and salt water exposure to assess long term depreciation risk.
