Driven by twin **Mercury** gas outboards, the model is designed for straightforward operation and reliable day to day performance. As a contemporary motor yacht built with a fiberglass construction, it delivers a comfortable platform for leisure time on the water. Q: Who builds the AV32? A: The boat is produced by AVIARA, a yard noted for practical layouts and contemporary build quality in this class.

Q: What powers the AV32? A: Propulsion comes from two **Mercury outboard** engines running on **gas** , chosen for straightforward upkeep and dependable performance.

Q: What are the key dimensions of the AV32? A: The **LOA** measures 32 ft (9.75 m) and the **beam** spans 10 ft (3.33 m), creating a confident footprint on the water.

Owner Experience Review

The AV32 from AVIARA is most often deployed as an upscale dayboat for family outings and social cruising. Its open cockpit beneath a hardtop and expansive aft sunpad across the beam cater to entertaining, while a compact cabin with a head enables short overnights or weekend stops; it is not configured like a full size cruiser. Dealers and reviewers commonly observe that the boat is well suited to coastal and near shore passages, including Bahamas style hops, when sea conditions remain moderate.

On the water, owners and reviewers report a dry, composed ride that slices through wakes and small seas without noticeable hull slap. The hull tracks predictably through turns with no chine walk; hard over turns produced approximately 12° of heel with consistent handling. Docking benefits from a sensitive, accurate joystick, and on Ilmor sterndrive versions Anchor/Location/Heading Assist features are available. In performance tests with twin Ilmor 380s the boat reached a top speed near 54.9 mph, cruised efficiently around 34.1 mph at roughly 3700 rpm, and achieved on plane in about 4.1 seconds.

Interior comfort is notable for a boat of this size: the head area offers about 5'9" of headroom with a ceramic toilet and a Corian sink, while appointments such as SeaDek flooring, heated seats (as one owner noted, "The seats are heated too."), and a billet aluminum windshield add an upscale touch.

Entertaining packages include an optional wet bar, refrigerator, and grill, and seating is flexible with flip up backrests on the full beam sunpad plus optional pop up aft "barstool" seats—though an expert observed "it's not clear how useful it would be." Practical aspects are generally favorable, with good storage and battery access beneath the walkway, although one reviewer recommended improving access to the anchor/rode locker. Routine maintenance follows typical patterns—50/100 hour checks and annual service, with engine OEM intervals observed whether the boat is outfitted with Ilmor sterndrives or Mercury outboards. No systemic issues have been widely reported in public forums, but long term owner feedback remains limited for a model introduced in 2019.

Pros and Cons

- Dry, predictable ride that handles chop and turns cleanly without chine walk.
- Precise joystick docking; Assist functions are offered on Ilmor sterndrive variants.
- Generous headroom and upscale appointments (SeaDek, heated seats, optional wet bar/fridge/grill) make it well suited to dayboating and short cruises.
- Optional pop up aft "barstool" seats received mixed reviews regarding their practicality.
- Entry to the anchor/rode locker could be more convenient.
- Limited long term owner data available since the model's 2019 introduction.
