OVERVIEW

Represented by Andrey Shestakov and the team at Shestakov Yacht Sales, the AV36 OB from AVIARA is a flexible motorboat built on a robust fiberglass and plastic foundation and driven by triple Mercury outboard motors. Measuring 36 ft LOA with a 10 ft beam, it offers assured handling combined with generous deck areas for enjoyable days afloat.

Selecting a AV36 OB

Deciding on the right AV36 OB layout depends on your intended cruising style and local water conditions. Its three Mercury outboards running on Gas/Petrol provide lively response and precise maneuvering, while the draft spread helps you assess access to nearby harbors and anchorages. Features of the Model

- Triple propulsion: outfitted with 3 x Mercury outboards (Gas/Petrol) to deliver sharp throttle control and simplified docking.
- Well-proportioned hull: 36 ft LOA paired with a 10 ft beam creates a stable, sociable platform for entertaining.
- Build materials: hull constructed of fiberglass and plastic with a Fiberglass deck.
- Cruising capacity: 214 gal fuel tank and 37 gal freshwater capacity to extend time between refueling and filling.
- Draft versatility: shallow and deep draft figures spanning a minimum of 8.475 ft to a maximum of 11.483 ft for varied marina and anchorage access.

Q: What powers the AV36 OB? A: The boat is propelled by 3 x **Mercury outboard engines** running on **Gas/Petrol**, offering responsive acceleration and handling.

Q: What are the key dimensions of the model? A: The overall length (LOA) is 36 ft (10.97 m) and the beam measures 10 ft (3.3 m), providing a stable, entertaining deck arrangement.

Q: What draft should I plan for in my home waters? A: Expect a **draft** that

ranges from a minimum of 8.475 ft (2.5833 m) to a maximum of 11.483 ft (3.5 m).

Q: What materials are used in construction? A: The vessel features a fiberglass and plastic hull with a Fiberglass deck.

Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly use the AV36 OB from AVIARA as an upscale dayboat or short-cruise weekender, and it rewards that role with a broad, convivial cockpit and high-quality finishes. The 10'10" beam and contemporary open-plan layout simplify hosting; the transom lounge conceals ample storage and reveals pop-up bar stools, while a thoughtfully organized helm and galley streamline entertaining. Below decks, the head and a cabin that reviewers describe as a snug private refuge support comfortable overnighting and daytime retreats.

Underway, the AV36 OB is frequently praised for its sure-footed stability and composed handling, coping well with wakes and chop while remaining agile. Published test runs report planing in approximately 4–7 seconds, an efficient cruise near 33–34 mph, and top-end speeds around 55–60 mph—ample for coastal hops and beach outings. At optimal cruise the range is cited at roughly 209 statute miles; the triple-outboard arrangement adds redundancy—if the center engine encounters an issue, propulsion can continue on the outer pair. The compromise is operating expense: at about 33.4 gph around 33.7 mph (roughly 1.0 mpg), fuel consumption is on the higher side, and as a fairly recent model (circa 2019–2020) widespread long-term reliability reports remain limited.

Pros and Cons

- Confident, steady ride with nimble handling that effectively manages wakes and choppy seas.
- Impressive dayboat performance, reaching plane in about 4–7 seconds with a best cruise near 33–34 mph and top speeds close to 55–60 mph.
- Layout focused on socializing: wide beam, refined fit and finish, adaptable transom lounge, and a comfortable cabin and head.
- Fuel consumption at cruise is relatively high (around 33.4 gph at roughly 33.7 mph), leading to increased operating costs.
- Tested cruise range of approximately 209 statute miles limits extended bluewater cruising for long passages.
- Being a recent design, there are relatively few long-term reliability anecdotes available publicly.
