Owner Experience Review

Owners and commentators generally position the AV36 Outboard from AVIARA as a premium dayboat ideal for entertaining and family outings. The roomy, sociable cockpit gets frequent praise—features such as a transom lounge, pop-up barstools, an efficiently laid-out wet bar, and an expansive swim platform make hosting effortless. Down below, the single-cabin/one-head configuration offers a cozy private space with approximately six feet of headroom, and common upgrades like air conditioning, a generator, Seakeeper 3, and enhanced audio/TV equipment convert it into a capable short-range weekender.

On the water, owners report steady stability and composed handling that remains nimble through wakes and chop. In triple-outboard installations it planes rapidly (around 4–7 seconds), cruises comfortably in the low to mid 30s mph (roughly 33–34 mph), and can hit top speeds in the mid 50s mph (about 55–60 mph) with triple 300s; joystick control and Mercury trim simplify low-speed maneuvering and docking. The downside noted by brokers and owners is fuel consumption: tests indicate about 33 gph when maintaining

roughly 33–34 mph.

Ownership notes emphasize the implications of a triple-outboard fitment. Routine access for maintenance is generally adequate, but three engines mean more service intervals, and a documented full 300-hour service on a 2022 example was approximately \$7,672. The model launched around 2020, so comprehensive long-term reliability trends remain limited in publicly available summaries.

Pros and Cons

- The spacious social cockpit—complete with transom lounge, wet bar, and a sizable swim platform—makes it excellent for entertaining and family recreation.
- Delivers a steady, composed ride with quick planing, responsive handling, and joystick-assisted docking for easier low-speed control.
- The compact one-cabin/one-head interior, with about six feet of headroom and optional packages (AC, generator, Seakeeper 3, upgraded audio/TV), supports comfortable short overnight trips.
- Triple-outboard setups increase the number of service items and raise operating costs compared with smaller single-outboard alternatives.
- Reported cruise fuel burn is fairly high—around 33 gph at approximately 33–34 mph.
- As a model introduced circa 2020, there is limited long-term reliability data available in the public domain.

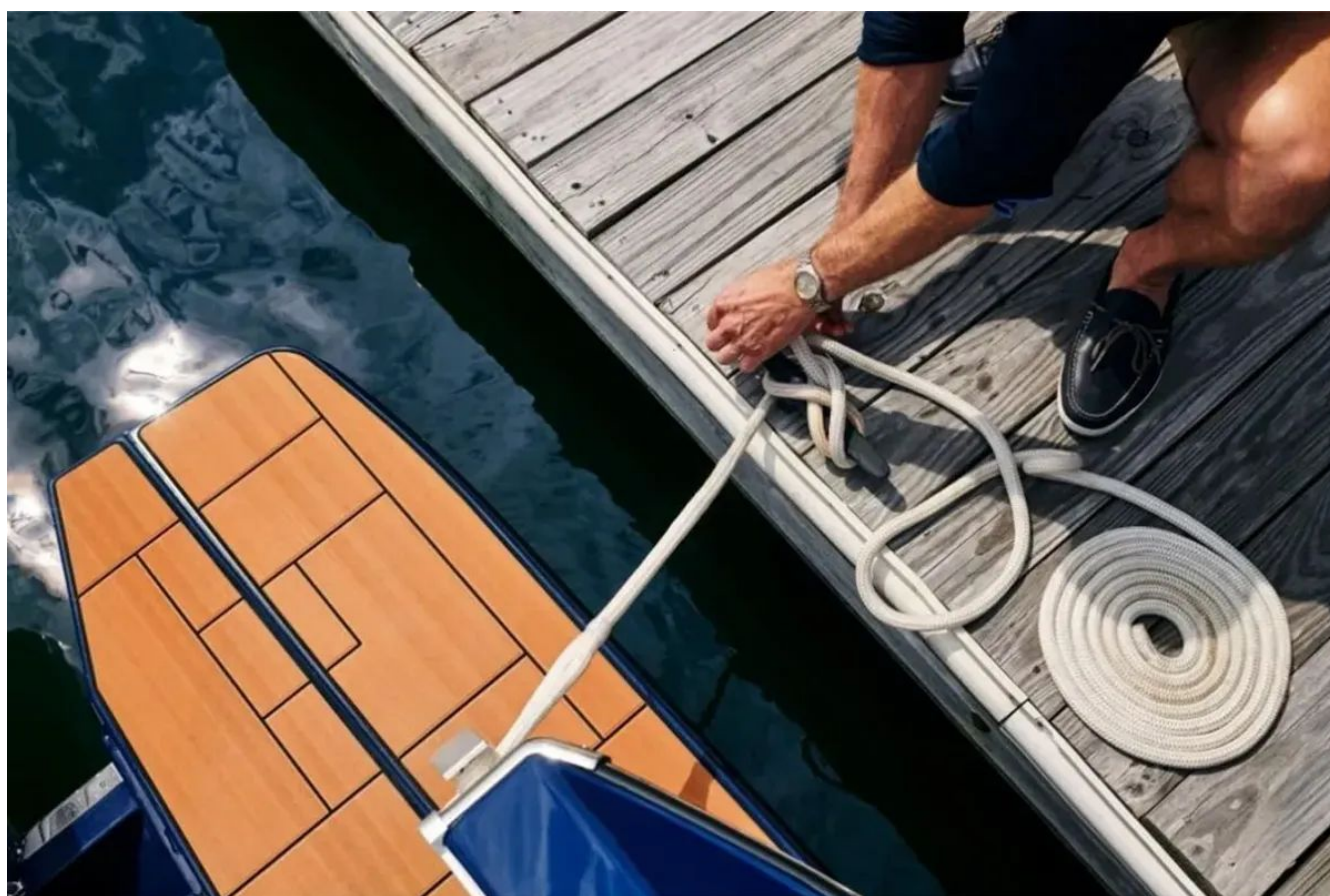
