## Owner Experience Review

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Owners typically employ the 37 Sun-Top Brabus Package by Axopar as a flexible dayboat for family island runs, beach stops, and social weekends. The open, highly social deck—featuring expansive forward and aft sunpads and adaptable seating—makes entertaining straightforward and keeps children comfortable between stops. Its layout also lends itself to day-charter use, underlining the model's practicality for short, lively trips.

On the water, the twin-step hull provides a sporty, composed ride in mild to

moderate seas. Owners and testers frequently note a comfortable cruising pace in the high-20s knots—about 28 kt with twin Mercury 300s—and reported top speeds near 45 kt, delivering confident handling for a 37-foot dayboat. It isn't designed as a heavy offshore passagemaker but rather as a spirited platform for fast day runs; one owner simply described it as “awesome.”

Under the Sun-Top, the Brabus Package emphasizes upgraded cosmetics and trim—black rails, a Brabus-branded wheel, suede-style touches—and certain Sun-Top configurations increase headroom to roughly 6'5". Overnight capability is modest, suitable for short stays, while most owners primarily use it for daytime outings. Routine upkeep is straightforward thanks to twin outboards (typical service through Mercury dealers on an annual or 100-hour schedule), though proper use of trim-tab and active-trim systems is important. The premium Brabus finishes, plus teak, soft-top elements, and upholstery, can add to maintenance needs; many owners choose dry storage to minimize wear.

## Pros and Cons

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- Very social deck plan with large forward and aft sunpads, ideal for day use and entertaining.
- Sporty, confident ride with a comfortable ~28-kt cruise and capable handling in mild-to-moderate seas.
- Twin outboards simplify access and routine service compared to inboards.
- Primarily a dayboat; cabin space suits short overnights rather than long-range cruising.
- Brabus Package focuses on cosmetic upgrades and is considered pricey by some owners.
- Trim-tab/active-trim systems and upscale finishes add attention and cost to upkeep.
