OVERVIEW

The 36M Grande from Azimut Yachts is a modern motor yacht built with a fiberglass and plastic hull and fiberglass deckwork. It combines a comfortable 19-knot cruising pace with a top speed near 24 knots and showcases award-winning Italian styling. This model is offered through Shestakov Yacht Sales with direct brokerage support from Andrey Shestakov.

Selecting a 36M Grande

When considering the 36M Grande with Shestakov Yacht Sales, begin by matching your cruising program and guest capacity needs to the yacht's capabilities. If you require a dependable 19-knot cruise with a 24-knot dash, appreciate a generous 300 GT volume across a 118 ft LOA and 24 ft beam, and need berthing for up to 10 guests with six heads, this model is an excellent fit within the motor yacht class. The hull belongs to the fiberglass and plastic segment and the fiberglass decks reduce upkeep while delivering good seakeeping. Naval architecture is by P.L AUSONIO Naval Architecture & Azimut Yachts R& D dept, and interiors are the work of M2 Atelier. Features of the Model

- Performance balance: a steady 19-knot cruise with the ability to reach 24 knots for flexible passages.
- Propulsion: twin MTU inboard diesel engines provide dependable propulsion and power.
- Design pedigree: naval architecture by P.L AUSONIO Naval Architecture & Azimut Yachts R& D dept, with interior styling by M2 Atelier.

- Guest comfort: configured to host up to 10 guests with 6 heads; dedicated crew quarters include 4 cabins and 6 berths.
- Construction: built on a fiberglass and plastic hull with fiberglass decks for longevity and simplified maintenance.
- Volume and capacities: 300 GT of internal volume, paired with 5,020 gal fuel capacity and 977 gal freshwater capacity to support extended voyages.

Q: What type of yacht is the 36M Grande? A: It is a motor yacht constructed on a fiberglass and plastic hull by Azimut Yachts, blending performance with **Italian design** and **efficient construction**.

Q: What are the principal dimensions? A: The yacht measures **LOA** 118 ft (35.97 m), **beam** 24 ft (7.49 m), and **draft** (min) 21.325 ft (6.5 m), delivering approximately **300 GT** of internal volume.

Q: How fast does it go? A: Typical **cruising speed** is 19 kn (21.86 mph) with a **maximum speed** around 24 kn (27.62 mph), powered by twin **MTU inboard diesel** units.

Q: How many people can stay aboard? A: Accommodations are arranged for up to **10 guests** with **6 heads**, and the crew quarters feature **4 cabins** and **6 berths** to support professional operation.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and crew using the 36M Grande typically split their time between family-oriented cruising and entertaining guests. Reviewers praise the full-beam owner's stateroom plus four guest cabins that together sleep up to 10, and they note that the expansive living areas and large glazing contribute to comfortable, extended stays aboard.

The semi-walkaround Infinity Skydeck, expansive retractable side windows, and a beach club with a fold-out platform enhance the seamless indoor/outdoor connection. A substantial sun deck with optional spa or pool supports weekend relaxation, watersports, and charter-style days. Multiple layout options and the skylounge/Infinity Skydeck configuration also make the yacht practical for owner-operators who prefer to run their own vessel.

On the water, owners and testers describe the D2P hull as steady at displacement speeds with a smooth shift into the planning regime; features like the wave-piercer bow and double chine improve efficiency and seakeeping. Typical cruising reports indicate around 18 knots, while published top speeds range from about 22 to 24 knots depending on whether the MTU 2200 or 2400 hp package is fitted. Owner forums and threads about Azimut Yachts sometimes raise post-delivery fit-and-finish concerns—examples include loose fasteners or unfinished bilge areas—and buyers should anticipate a punch list after handover. There are also accounts of disputed warranty handling and occasional legal friction, though Evo/2026 updates have introduced improvements such as enhanced engine-room insulation that suggest the builder is iterating based on owner feedback.

Pros and Cons

- Versatile indoor/outdoor living enabled by the Infinity Skydeck and large

retractable side windows.

- A family- and charter-oriented layout with a full-beam owner's suite plus four guest cabins accommodating up to 10 guests.
- D2P hull featuring a wave-piercer bow and double chine for a composed ride and efficient transition to plane, with roughly an ~18-kn cruise and ~22–24-kn top speed depending on engine choice.
- Forum reports note post-delivery fit-and-finish issues (for example, loose screws or unfinished bilges) that typically require attention.
- Some owners and brokers have reported contentious warranty interactions and even legal disputes involving Azimut Yachts.
- A punch list following handover is commonly expected—"there will be problems (it's a boat)."
