OVERVIEW

The 42 Flybridge from Azimut Yachts is an elegant motor yacht crafted for owners who demand both spirited performance and onboard comfort. Built on a reliable fiberglass and plastic hull, this cruiser balances seakeeping and everyday usability. Represented by Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales, our brokerage delivers hands-on guidance through selection, inspection, and delivery, ensuring a seamless purchase experience.

Selecting a 42 Flybridge

Opting for the 42 Flybridge is a sound choice for buyers who want a blend of speed and livability. Twin inboard **CAT** diesel engines enable a comfortable 26-knot cruising pace (29.92 mph) with a possible top end near 32 knots (36.83 mph) under favorable conditions. Designed to sleep 4 and fitted with 2 heads, the layout accommodates couples, small families, or groups planning extended weekends afloat. The Deep Vee hull form combined with a fiberglass and plastic hull emphasizes a steady motion and relatively low upkeep, while tankage—430 gal fuel and 130 gal water—supports meaningful time away from port.

Q: What type of yacht is the 42 Flybridge? A: The 42 Flybridge is a motor yacht configured as a capable cruiser with a resilient fiberglass and plastic hull. This combination suits family cruising and weekend escapes.

Q: What are the key performance figures? A: Cruising speed is 26 knots (29.92 mph) and the top speed is approximately 32 knots (36.83 mph), propelled by twin **CAT** inboard diesel engines for assured passage-making.

Q: How many people can stay aboard comfortably? A: The interior provides **accommodations** for 4 with **2 heads** , making it practical for a couple with guests or a small family.

Q: What are the main dimensions and draft? A: LOA measures 42 ft (12.8 m) and the maximum draft is 11.209 ft (3.4166 m), matched with the Deep Vee hull for capable handling.

Owner Experience Review

Constructed by Azimut Yachts, the 42 Flybridge is often noted by owners as a versatile platform suitable for day-charter duties and weekends for two couples. The usual two-cabin, two-head configuration with a sociable salon and galley-down plan is well suited to family cruising, while the roomy flybridge with seating and sunpads supports relaxed social outings. Interiors tend to reflect late-1990s design cues—glossy cherry joinery with light headlinings. Many owners upgrade the original helm benches to adjustable seats for

improved ergonomics. Lazarette capacity is modest; owners commonly stow larger items through the cockpit hatch into the engine-room void.

Underway, operators report a solid, seakindly demeanor that is predictable even if not the most agile among flybridge boats. A comfortable cruise is cited around 20 knots at approximately 2,000 rpm, with top speeds reported between 30 and 33 knots depending on engine fit and condition. Several owners note it handles confidently into head seas and performs well in moderate weather. Typical installed power is the Caterpillar 3126-series; owners advise watching for early soft-block variants and recommend servicing and cleaning aftercoolers every 2–3 years. With age come additional considerations: circular electric windows are known to fail, some examples show gelcoat crazing or blistering (osmosis checks recommended), helm wiring can be untidy, and while cockpit-hatch access to the engine room is generous, space beside external engine components can be tight for major repairs. Reported production years commonly run 1998–2005, with examples from the mid-1990s up to 2007.

Pros and Cons

- Very good seakeeping and a predictable ride; a comfortable cruise is about 20 knots at ~2,000 rpm.
- Generous flybridge seating and sunpads make it ideal for day-charter operations and social weekends.
- The practical 2-cabin/2-head layout suits two couples or family cruising well.
- Handling is described by multiple owners as not the sharpest among flybridge designs.
- Maintenance watchpoints include Caterpillar 3126 aftercoolers that need regular attention and earlier soft-block variants that warrant inspection.
- Age-related and nuisance issues can include failing circular electric windows, a limited dedicated lazarette, and potential gelcoat crazing or blistering.
