## OVERVIEW

---

The 48 Flybridge from Azimut Yachts pairs Stefano Righini's exterior styling with Carlo Galeazzi's interior vision. This motor yacht is built on a fiberglass construction platform and is driven by twin Cummins inboard diesel engines, offering a comfortable 25-knot cruise and a 32-knot top speed. Presented by Andrey Shestakov and the team at Shestakov Yacht Sales.

### Selecting a 48 Flybridge

---

Opting for the 48 Flybridge means choosing a model with a balanced mix of styling, onboard comfort, and seagoing capability. Measuring 48 ft (14.63 m) LOA with a 14 ft (4.3 m) beam, the monohull form yields predictable handling, while the 13.123 ft (4 m) draft reflects its offshore readiness.

Inside, the layout provides sleeping space for 4 and seating/berth accommodations for 6, complemented by 2 heads. There's also a crew cabin with 2 berths to support professional operation when required. Twin Cummins inboard diesels propel the yacht at a cruising speed of 25 knots (approximately 28.77 mph) and can reach up to 32 knots (approximately 36.83 mph) at full throttle.

With hull lines by Stefano Righini and interior appointments by Carlo Galeazzi, the 48 Flybridge is executed in a fiberglass construction for durability and efficiency at sea.

- Designed cruise of 25 knots and top speed of 32 knots (28.77/36.83 mph)

## Questions and Answers

---

Q: What is the cruising speed of the 48 Flybridge? A: The **cruising speed** is 25 knots (about 28.77 mph), with a **maximum speed** of 32 knots (about 36.83 mph).

Q: What is the draft of the yacht? A: The **draft** is 13.123 ft (4 m), listed as both minimum and maximum in the specifications.

Q: How many people can sleep on board and how many heads are there? A: The yacht **sleeps 4** , offers **accommodations for 6** , and has **2 heads** .

Q: What engines power the yacht and what fuel do they use? A: It's powered by **2 Cummins inboard diesel** engines. The **fuel capacity** is 528 gallons.

Q: What is the hull made from and how is it configured? A: The hull is a fiberglass composite **monohull** , and the **deck** is fiberglass.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners commonly deploy the 48 Flybridge from Azimut Yachts for

family-focused coastal cruising and short weekend passages, benefiting from a three-cabin layout that nicely accommodates 4–6 guests. Expansive side windows flood the interior with daylight, while the flybridge and cockpit layouts are oriented toward socializing; many examples are fitted with flybridge refrigeration and barbecue setups.

Performance figures cited by brokers typically show cruising in the mid-20s (knots) with top speeds near 32 knots, and owners frequently praise the model for its pace. In rough or confused conditions some owners note the ride can feel livelier and occasionally wetter compared with heavier U.S.-built counterparts. Interior finishes are generally well regarded, however several owners report limited access behind panels, repeated minor electrical or mechanical issues, and extended waits for replacement parts or warranty assistance; a number have modified access panels to reach fuse and terminal blocks. Common powerplants include Cummins QSC 8.3L units (with earlier builds sometimes fitted with CAT), and owners report that routine parts and dealer labor can be expensive.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Three-cabin arrangement with large windows provides generous interior volume and abundant natural light.
- Flybridge and cockpit areas are well suited to entertaining, with fridge/BBQ configurations commonly noted.
- Joystick steering is often installed and greatly simplifies docking and close-quarters handling.
- Access to electronic and service systems can be restricted, complicating maintenance tasks.
- Owners report recurring small electrical and mechanical issues and long delays for parts and warranty support.
- In confused seas the boat's motion can feel livelier and sometimes wetter

than that of heavier U.S.-built yachts.
