OVERVIEW

Crafted by Azimut Yachts, the 55 S represents a modern take on the motor yacht concept, pairing a triple diesel propulsion package with practical, guest-centric accommodations. Its monohull built from fiberglass and plastic is engineered for brisk, confident cruising for six guests plus crew. Listed and presented by Andrey Shestakov of Shestakov Yacht Sales.

Selecting a 55 S

Opt for the 55 S when you want a sporty, easily handled motor yacht that still offers comfortable room for family or friends and the convenience of a dedicated crew cabin. With a typical cruise of 30 kn and a top end of 35 kn powered by three Volvo Penta diesel engines, plus accommodations laid out for six guests and crew space, it's a strong choice for owners focused on lively day trips and weekend coastal passages within the motor yachts category.

- Performance-focused propulsion: three Volvo Penta diesel engines delivering a 30 kn cruise (34.52 mph) and a 35 kn top speed (40.28 mph)
- LOA 55 ft (16.76 m), beam 15 ft (4.7 m), draft 11.22 ft (3.42 m)
- Monohull with a fiberglass and plastic construction; deck finished in Fiberglass
- Hull and interior styling by AZIMUT YACHTS
- Sleeps 6 with 2 heads; separate crew cabin (1) providing up to 2 berths
- Fuel capacity 423 gal; fresh water capacity 156 gal
- Gross tonnage 26.68 GT

Questions and Answers

Q: What type of yacht is the 55 S? A: It's a **motor yacht** positioned within the

motor yachts segment.

Q: How fast does it go? A: The 55 S operates at a **cruise speed** of 30 kn (34.52 mph) and reaches a **max speed** of 35 kn (40.28 mph).

Q: How many people can stay onboard? A: **Accommodations** are configured for 6 (sleeps 6) with **2 heads** , plus a **crew cabin** offering up to 2 berths.

Q: What engines power the yacht? A: Triple **Volvo Penta diesel** engines (3 total) provide the propulsion.

Q: What is the hull and deck construction? A: The yacht is built on a **monohull** with a **fiberglass and plastic hull** and a **Fiberglass** deck.

Owner Experience Review

Owners are drawn to the 55 S from Azimut Yachts for relaxed weekend outings and family coastal cruising; the model is also commonly seen in short term private charter fleets. Real world performance and owner reports typically show a lively mid 20 knot cruising pace — approximately 23–24 knots at about 2,000 rpm — with agile helm response for a 55 foot sport yacht. The hull lines emphasize a sporty silhouette, though several owners report it can take on a bit more spray in choppy conditions.

Inside, the full beam master suite is frequently praised for its light and efficient layout, and the three cabin, two head arrangement generally accommodates six people comfortably. The interior styling receives favorable comments for its modern, attractive look, while forum threads note variability in fit and finish, including trim pieces secured with snaps or Velcro. While the yacht is capable of longer passages, the forepeak/crew berth is compact and overall dedicated crew facilities are limited for extended liveaboard use.

Serviceability and systems are common themes in ownership feedback: some

routine maintenance points are awkward to reach, and owners and technicians have discussed intermittent electrical quirks and components that may need attention after delivery. Forums also record occasional transmission or engine sensor warnings and vibration at certain rpms; additionally, some earlier 55 foot examples from Azimut Yachts experienced hull issues that required warranty work.

Pros and Cons

- Brisk performance and responsive handling with an easy mid 20 knot cruise around 23–24 knots at ~2,000 rpm.
- Full beam master and 3 cabin/2 head layout comfortably accommodate six, with chic interior styling.
- Well suited to weekend family coastal cruising and short term charters, with extended trips possible for owners who can forgo dedicated crew space.
- The forepeak/crew berth is cramped and dedicated crew space is limited for longer liveaboard use.
- The sportier profile can deliver a wetter ride in chop.
- Owners report variable fit and finish, tight service access, and occasional electrical gremlins or sensor warnings.
