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OVERVIEW

The 64 Flybridge from Azimut Yachts is a contemporary motor yacht that maintains a 28-knot cruising speed and can reach up to 34 knots. Measuring 66 ft overall and constructed with a fiberglass and plastic hull combined with a Carbon Fiber deck, it accommodates 4 guests and includes 3 heads. Selecting a 64 Flybridge

If you want a blend of performance and practical onboard accommodations, the 64 Flybridge is laid out on a 66 ft (20.14 m) platform with a 16 ft (5.06 m) beam and a minimum draft of 15.584 ft (4.75 m). Twin CAT inboard diesels propel the boat to a 28-knot cruise and a 34-knot top speed. With 1,030 gallons of fuel capacity and 259 gallons of water, plus sleeping for 4 and 3 heads, this motor yacht is aimed at owners seeking speed, comfort, and composite construction. Owner Experience Review

Owners often choose the 64 Flybridge from Azimut Yachts as an owner-operated flybridge in the 60–65 ft segment. Its three-cabin plus crew arrangement suits family cruising and weekend escapes. The model is commonly found on charter rosters in Fort Lauderdale and Miami, and the boat's systems are generally configured for owner operation rather than continuous crewed service. Built in a roughly 2010–2015 production run with about 96 hulls, it is well represented on the used market.

Underway, owners and sea-trials describe brisk acceleration and solid midrange torque—approximately 0–30 knots in ~16 seconds—with handling that reviewers find enjoyable and composed in a swell. The yacht will remain on plane at relatively low RPMs for an efficient slow-planing cruise and benefits from large fuel tanks for range; reported top speed is around 34 knots. Some users have noted reduced visibility at times due to reflections on the windscreen in certain lighting conditions.

Aboard, the full-beam amidships master, complete with a breakfast dinette and a walk-in wardrobe, is frequently singled out for its spaciousness and storage. The 21 m² flybridge, fitted with a wet bar, grill, and adaptable seating, is widely regarded as the primary social area. The main-deck galley/bar layout

and expansive salon glazing make the yacht comfortable for liveboard-style use when properly maintained, and the three-cabin + crew setup works for family owners and occasional charter duties. Potential maintenance items to budget for include variable electrical installations between hulls, reports of leaking window seals and hatches, cracked plastic thru-hulls and failing hoses, gelcoat moisture blisters beneath flybridge seating, and intermittent hydraulic issues (trim tabs, platform, steering). Engine-room access is confined via a cockpit-sole ladder; Caterpillar C18 engines enjoy broad support, but custom Azimut Yachts components can require several weeks to source. Forum commentary ranges from pragmatic to blunt, including quotes such as “Azimut is the SHEIN of boats” and “Azimuts are trash.”

Pros and Cons

- Spacious 21 m² flybridge with wet bar, grill, and flexible seating serves as a standout social hub.
- Full-beam master with breakfast dinette and walk-in wardrobe offers volume and storage owners praise.
- Quick acceleration (~0–30 kt in ~16 s) with rewarding handling and the ability to stay on plane at low RPM.
- Variability in electrical installation between hulls can complicate troubleshooting and repairs.
- Owner-reported issues include leaking window seals/hatches, cracked plastic thru-hulls, hose failures, gelcoat blisters under flybridge seats, and occasional hydraulic-system faults.
- Tight engine-room access via cockpit-sole ladder and several-week lead times for bespoke Azimut Yachts parts.
