OVERVIEW

The 84 from Azimut Yachts is a purpose built motor yacht designed for flexible cruising and onboard comfort. Measuring 84 ft (25.7 m) overall with a 21 ft (6.45 m) beam, twin MAN inboard diesel powerplants, and a sturdy fiberglass and plastic hull, it sleeps 8 guests plus 3 crew, maintains a 22 kn (25.32 mph) cruising pace, and can reach 27 kn (31.07 mph). Selecting a 84

Opting for the 84 is a decision driven by its combination of interior volume, seaworthiness, and economical long range ability. With a gross tonnage of 100 and a wide 21 ft beam, it delivers substantial living space; twin MAN inboard diesels provide reliable propulsion for a steady 22 knot cruise and a 27 knot top end when needed. The monohull design, relatively shallow 5.873 ft (1.79 m) draft, and fiberglass and plastic construction with a GRP deck make it suitable for family voyages, charter operations, and varied coastal itineraries.

Features of the Model

- Propulsion: 2 MAN inboard diesel engines deliver dependable, efficient thrust.
- Performance: Designed for a 22 kn cruise and a 27 kn top speed to keep schedules on track.
- Layout: Sleeping arrangements for 8 guests plus 3 crew beds support extended stays aboard.
- Build: Monohull built with a fiberglass and plastic hull materials and GRP deck for strength and simplified upkeep.
- Capacities: 1,690.7 gal fuel capacity and 356.63 gal fresh water capacity strike

a balance between range and comfort.

- Dimensions: 84 ft LOA and 21 ft beam enhance onboard stability and interior volume.

Questions and Answers

Q: What are the cruising and maximum speeds of the 84? A: The yacht's **cruising speed** is 22 kn (25.32 mph) and its **maximum speed** is 27 kn (31.07 mph).

Q: How many people can the 84 accommodate? A: The vessel offers **accommodation** for 8 guests and comes with **3 crew beds** to support onboard service and operation.

Q: What engines power the 84? A: Power is provided by **2 MAN inboard diesel** engines, chosen for dependable performance and fuel efficiency.

Q: What is the draft, and why does it matter? A: The **maximum draft** is 5.873 ft (1.79 m), allowing access to shallower anchorages and many marinas while still providing good underway stability.

Q: What is the hull and deck construction? A: This model is a monohull constructed with a fiberglass and plastic **hull** and features a **GRP deck**, offering durability and relatively low maintenance demands.

Owner Experience Review

Owners typically use the 84 from Azimut Yachts for family coastal cruising, owner skippered multi day passages, and frequent day charter operations. The US (MarineMax) layout, with its open galley flowing into the saloon, is celebrated for making social cooking easy; below decks you'll often find a full beam owner's stateroom with private access, three guest cabins, and a separate crew area. Expansive flybridge zones and ample deck space promote outdoor living, and several hulls have been fitted or plumbed for a Jacuzzi. As one owner put it: "smooth ride, luxurious interior."

Underway, the deep V planing hull generally yields a comfortable, stable

motion for an 84-foot planing yacht. Captains report the helm is steady though on the heavier side; optimal handling comes with correct trim and an appropriate engine setup. Some reviews and listings note a comfortable cruise around 24 knots on individual boats, with listed top speeds reported in the high 20s to around 28–30 knots depending on hull condition and equipment.

Ownership narratives also call out maintenance considerations: threads reference water ingress, air conditioning breakdowns, generator issues, and intermittent electrical faults. Prospective owners are advised to budget for significant service and parts expenses for large main engines and generators. Practical features such as crew or swim platform access to the engine room—and in certain yachts, an engine room camera—aid daily operations, although some forum posts mention unfinished fiberglass in bilge areas. Warranty and dealer support experiences vary; reports include slow responses from dealers and at least one account of receiving a legal “cease and desist” during a dispute.

Pros and Cons

- Deep V hull delivers a generally smooth, stable ride for an 84-foot planing yacht.
- Social main deck layout on the US version with an open galley suits entertaining.
- Full beam owner’s suite, three guest cabins, and a large flybridge support family cruising and charter work.
- Owners report water leaks, A/C and generator faults, and electrical gremlins on some boats.
- Handling is stable but heavy and benefits from correct trim and adequate engine configuration.
- Forum reports cite slow warranty response and at least one legal threat in a service dispute.
