OVERVIEW

Discover the Azimut Yachts 95 RPH, an upscale motor yacht built on a fiberglass-and-plastic platform that measures 93 ft overall with a 23 ft beam and offers a reliable performance band of roughly 15–21 knots. Shestakov Yacht Sales — represented by broker Andrey Shestakov — is available to assist with evaluation, sea trials, and acquisition of this distinguished model.

Selecting a 95 RPH

Opting for the 95 RPH from Azimut Yachts is a logical choice if you require a roomy motor-yacht that balances interior volume (beam 23 ft / 7.07 m) with capable cruising performance. The model's typical cruise of 15 kn (17.26 mph) and maximum of 21 kn (24.17 mph), along with substantial fuel (3,170.06 gal) and water (528.34 gal) capacities and dedicated crew quarters, make it well suited to owners who value onboard comfort on extended passages within the motor-yacht class.

Features of the Model

- Twin MTU inboard diesel powerplants provide dependable propulsion and are configured for straightforward maintenance access.
- A fiberglass/GRP hull paired with GRP decks delivers durability while keeping structural weight efficient.
- Guest arrangements accommodate up to 10 people, with sleeping for 6 and six heads to maximize privacy and convenience.
- Two crew cabins offering 4 crew berths support professional operation and guest service standards.
- Operationally practical performance: comfortable cruise at 15 kn (17.26 mph) and a top speed of 21 kn (24.17 mph).

Questions and Answers

- What type of yacht is the 95 RPH? The 95 RPH is a luxury motor-yacht within the broader motor-yacht class, constructed on a fiberglass-and-plastic construction hull. This designation emphasizes its focus on **comfort** , **performance** , and private cruising capability.
- How fast does it go? Nominally the vessel cruises at 15 kn (17.26 mph) and reaches a maximum of 21 kn (24.17 mph), providing a useful speed envelope for varied itineraries and scheduling needs.
- How many people can stay on board? The layout supports up to **10** onboard, with berths for **6** , and **6 heads** to enhance guest privacy. Crew accommodation comprises **2 crew cabins** with **4 berths** to facilitate professional operation.
- What engines and fuel does it use? Propulsion is delivered by **2 MTU Inboard Diesel** engines, pairing established manufacturer reliability with an installation designed for routine servicing.

Owner Experience Review

Owners are frequently drawn to the 95 RPH for its practical onboard liveability: the raised pilothouse allows a full main-deck owner's stateroom with expansive sightlines, while full-height salon windows and a flybridge of about

60 m² create an airy social environment suitable for larger families and guests. Below decks, four guest staterooms plus separate forward crew quarters preserve privacy, and the stern garage's capacity to convert into a beach club while storing an approximately 4 m tender enhances daily usability. The layout is often used for family cruising, owner-operator weekends, and charter-style entertaining.

Underway, owners and captains report a measured compromise between speed and comfort for a 29 m planing yacht: many examples cruise in the 20–22 knot range with top speeds approaching 26–28 knots, and a significant number are fitted with fin stabilizers to improve ride quality and directional control. The model's CE Class A rating and commonly listed cruise range of approximately 350–450 nautical miles support extended coastal passages as well as "mothership" operations with a tender or chase boat. Press commentary also notes that this model sits near regulatory thresholds — often cited around ~29 m/24 m — that can yield registration or compliance benefits in certain jurisdictions.

Maintenance accounts vary. Discussion forum feedback has raised issues on some boats related to build finish and warranty responsiveness, including reports of unfinished fiberglass in bilges and loose deck fittings. Conversely, many brokerage listings document well-managed 95 RPH examples with low engine hours and complete service histories, indicating that condition typically hinges on the boat's maintenance record and the attention of its captain.

Pros and Cons

- Main-deck owner's suite with four guest cabins below and separate crew quarters delivers excellent privacy for large-family cruising or charter operations.
- Raised Pilot House enhances sightlines and makes owner-operation more

feasible on a yacht of this scale.

- A flybridge of roughly 60 m² and a stern garage convertible to a beach club that carries an approximately 4 m tender support entertaining and provide versatile water access.
- Forum reports have pointed to build-quality concerns such as unfinished fiberglass in bilges and loose screws on deck.
- Some owners have described contentious warranty interactions with Azimut Yachts.
- The typical cruise range of roughly 350–450 nm requires planning for fuel stops on longer passages.
