## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners are drawn to the Atlantis 48 by Azimut Yachts for weekend family cruises and energetic day outings. The two-cabin arrangement comfortably hosts about four guests, anchored by a full-beam aft master and supported by two heads equipped with walk-in showers. The interior reads bright and modern, featuring a functional galley and a convertible dinette that simplify short-term liveaboard life; one owner online even described theirs as “a very rare jewel.”

On the water, the vessel delivers the sporty-cruiser character many buyers anticipate: typical cruising figures sit around 30 knots with top speeds reaching the mid-30s, and handling is frequently described as confident and “sporty” in calm to moderate seas. The design emphasis clearly leans toward performance and onboard entertaining rather than extended offshore seakeeping, and some examples have seen light charter work in Mediterranean waters.

Daytime entertaining benefits from a social cockpit trimmed in teak, generous

seating, options for grilling and entertainment, a retractable soft-top, expansive sunpads, a hydraulic swim platform, and a sundeck that includes a garage. Owners also note practical caveats: variability in electrical and systems fit-out between individual boats and reports of issues such as leaking window seals, generator faults, occasional engine overheating, and stabilizer problems. Engine-room access is through a cockpit hatch and ladder and can be constricted for maintenance, and there are public reports of post-sale warranty or claim disagreements.

## Pros and Cons

- Sporty performance with an around-30-knot cruise, mid-30s top speed, and handling owners praise.
- Full-beam aft master with two cabins and two heads supports comfortable family weekendening for about four guests.
- Social cockpit and deck plan with retractable soft-top, sunpads, grill options, hydraulic swim platform, and a sundeck/garage.
- Not ideal for long-range cruising compared with designs that prioritize seakeeping.
- Variability in electrical and systems installations, with reports of leaking window seals, generator faults, occasional engine overheating, and stabilizer faults.
- Engine-room access via cockpit hatch and ladder can be tight for service.
