## OVERVIEW

---

Presented by Shestakov Yacht Sales, the Atlantis 51 by Azimut Yachts is a streamlined performance motor yacht positioned in the wider motor-yacht segment. Built on a durable fiberglass/GRP platform, it delivers a blend of sporty capability and comfortable accommodation. For availability and expert advice, contact broker Andrey Shestakov.

## Selecting an Atlantis 51

---

If your brief calls for a sporty vessel that still provides comfortable living spaces, the Atlantis 51 offers a well judged compromise between speed and volume. Measuring 53 ft (16.18 m) overall with a 15 ft (4.7 m) beam, it presents ample deck area and interior room. Its draft, from 3.609–4.265 ft (1.1–1.3 m), allows access to a wide range of marinas and anchorages. Designed for performance, she cruises at 28 kn (32.22 mph) and will push to a 32 kn (36.83 mph) top end. Overnighting arrangements accommodate six guests with three heads plus a crew cabin for two. ## Features of the Model

---

- Propulsion: Twin Volvo inboard diesel engines deliver dependable power and efficiency.
- Performance: Capable of a 28 kn cruising speed and a 32 kn maximum for brisk passages.
- Construction: Monohull form built with a fiberglass/GRP hull and a GRP deck, offering a strong strength-to-weight ratio.
- Design pedigree: Both the hull lines and the interior layout were developed

by Azimut Yachts.

- Accommodation plan: Configured to sleep 6 guests with 3 heads; crew quarters comprise 1 cabin with 2 berths.

- The Atlantis 51 delivers a **cruising speed** of 28 kn (32.22 mph) and a **maximum speed** of 32 kn (36.83 mph).

## Owner Experience Review

---

Owners describe the Atlantis 51 from Azimut Yachts as an effective family weekender and coastal cruiser, largely due to its three-cabin arrangement and a flowing, single-level main deck enhanced by extensive glazing. The cockpit layout paired with substantial sunpads makes day entertaining effortless, while a hydraulic swim platform and a capacious tender garage increase enjoyment when anchored, albeit at the expense of some internal machinery space.

When underway, the Volvo Penta IPS installation provides engaging handling that owners find responsive for pod-driven craft; joystick-assisted docking eases close-quarters handling in tight marina situations. Independent test data lists an efficient cruise near 22.7 mph at 2250 rpm, a top-end close to 37.6 mph at 3100 rpm, and a planing time around seven seconds. The boat exhibits roughly an 8° bow rise, a hull form that controls spray well, and a modest turning characteristic around 15° that feels steady and predictable.

Access to the engine room is through a cockpit sole hatch; while service access exists via crawl spaces around machinery, the room is generally described as compact. Typical owner maintenance includes regular IPS/pod servicing, upkeep of platform and tender-garage hydraulics, and attention to SeaKeeper access; many owners note that parts and service for European-sourced systems can require lead time. Forum feedback on build quality and warranty support is mixed—some owners suggest components can feel inexpensive and that long-term durability varies—but the consensus still regards the Atlantis 51 as suitable for extended coastal passages, with many owners using it for multi-day trips.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Three-cabin layout and a luminous, single-level main deck make it ideal for

family-oriented weekendening and onboard entertaining.

- Volvo Penta IPS delivers responsive, predictable handling and simplifies docking with joystick control.
- Independent tests report fast planing (approximately 7 s) and solid speed figures (best cruise ~22.7 mph; top ~37.6 mph).
- Engine-room space is tight, with much access limited to crawl areas despite reasonable overall service reach.
- A large tender garage and hydraulic swim platform contribute to reduced machinery volume as a design compromise.
- Owners note concerns about build quality and warranty responsiveness, and parts/service for European systems may take longer to source.

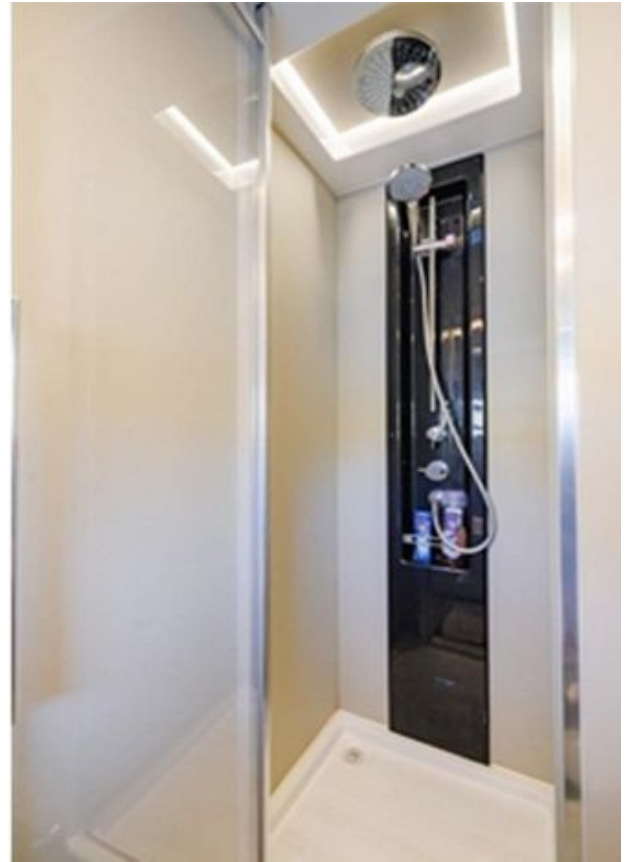

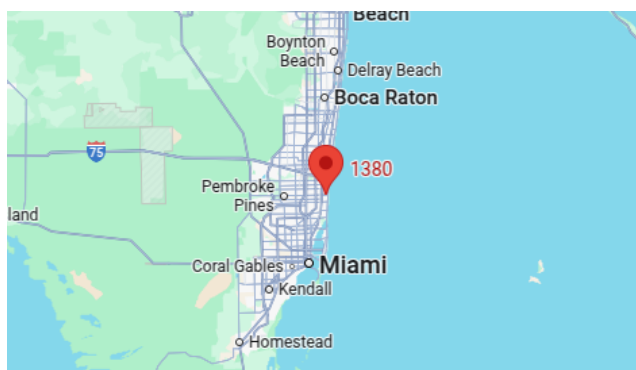
