OVERVIEW

The Azimut Grande 27M by Azimut Yachts is a modern motor yacht fashioned on a fiberglass and plastic platform with a refined Semi-Displacement hull form that merges performance with classic Italian styling. The naval architecture is credited to P.L. Ausonio Naval Architecture in collaboration with the Azimut R&D Dept, while the interior environment is by Achille Salvagni Architetti. The layout accommodates up to 10 people and provides sleeping space for 7.

Opting for the Azimut Grande 27M is well suited to owners who want a capable motor yacht that delivers reassuring performance alongside refined living areas. Built on a fiberglass and plastic foundation with a Semi-Displacement hull, it finds a balance between seakeeping efficiency and onboard comfort. - Q: What type of yacht is the Azimut Grande 27M? A: It is a motor yacht constructed on a fiberglass and plastic platform with a Semi-Displacement hull form that blends efficiency and onboard comfort.
- Q: What are the performance figures? A: The Azimut Grande 27M achieves a **cruise speed** of 24 kn (27.62 mph) and a **maximum speed** of 28 kn (32.22 mph).
- Q: Who designed and built the yacht? A: **Builder** : Azimut Yachts. **Naval architecture** by P.L. Ausonio Naval Architecture in collaboration with Azimut R&D Dept. **Interior design** by Achille Salvagni Architetti.

Owner Experience Review

Owners transitioning up from 60–75 ft frequently report that the Azimut Grande 27M delivers the sensation of a “big boat” within an approximately 88 ft envelope. Manufactured by Azimut Yachts, many are operated as crewed private yachts. The arrangement suits family cruising or occasional charters with a main deck, full beam owner suite featuring expansive glazing, 4–5 cabin layouts, and luminous main deck social areas with floor to ceiling windows. The flybridge, foredeck lounge, tender garage with access to a

beach club/hydraulic platform, and raised pilothouse delivering professional helm ergonomics make it versatile for weekend entertaining and longer coastal passages.

In practice, owners and reviewers describe the Azimut Grande 27M as notably nimble, maintaining a flat attitude underway with an estimated 18 m turning circle. Common installations feature twin MAN V12 1,900 hp engines, producing a comfortable mid 20 knot cruise (about 24 knots) and top speeds close to 28 knots; the broad beam hull, carbon fibre superstructure, and fin stabilizers all help deliver a steady, low roll experience both underway and at anchor. Prospective owners should budget for realistic maintenance: Italian electrical runs can be densely packed, several owner reports note leaks in predictable spots and various post-delivery quality control items, and there have been warranty/build finish disputes. Plan for comprehensive surveys, routine MAN engine servicing, occasional haul outs for stabilizer and shaft maintenance, and an appropriate crew and service reserve.

Pros and Cons

- Main deck, full beam owner suite with very large windows that offer exceptional views for this size.
- Responsive and stable handling with an ~18 m turning circle; mid 20 knot cruise and near 28 knot top speed on MAN V12 installations.
- Airy, sociable interior layout suited to family life and entertaining, complemented by flybridge, foredeck lounge, tender garage and beach club/hydraulic platform.
- Complex electrical and systems architecture means a thorough pre-purchase inspection is essential and ownership requires attentiveness.
- Documented leaks at common locations and other post-delivery QC issues suggest careful inspection of seals and fit-out is advisable.
- Owner forum accounts reference warranty and build finish disputes and

indicate the need to budget for MAN servicing, stabilizer/shaft haul outs, and crew/service costs.
