The Fly 78 from Azimut Yachts is a motor yacht positioned in the motor yachts segment. Its hull is constructed from fiberglass and plastic and it rides on a Carbon Fiber deck. Measuring 78 ft overall with an 18 ft beam and capable of reaching up to 33 knots, the design blends contemporary materials, sizeable onboard volume, and performance for discerning owners.

Opting for the Fly 78 places emphasis on a well-established motor yacht platform within the broader motor yachts class that is engineered for brisk cruising and efficient operation. The propulsion package includes three Volvo engines to ensure reliable power, and the interior plan—accommodating 3 sleeping berths and 4 heads—offers practical flexibility for a variety of cruising scenarios.

Owner Experience Review

Many owners select the Fly 78 from Azimut Yachts for family-focused cruising and weekends where the owner operates the yacht. The joystick/IPS handling makes tight maneuvering and marina work much more manageable. Feedback from owners and guests frequently highlights a composed ride and a refined onboard ambiance, with typical real-world cruise speeds observed around 26–27 kt and top-end runs commonly reaching 31–33 kt. Some vessels operate in light charter environments where the boat's ease of handling and guest circulation are advantageous.

Internally, the four-cabin arrangement—often featuring a full-beam master suite—is praised for its roominess and privacy. The Full-Lounge salon configuration and a well-appointed galley support extended cruising and entertaining. Social areas such as the flybridge and foredeck are consistently noted as favorite gathering spots, providing multiple comfortable zones for family and guests.

However, multiple owner and surveyor reports raise recurring maintenance issues: unfinished fiberglass in bilge areas, leaking hatch and window seals, and instances of loose fasteners have required corrective work and, in some cases, difficult warranty discussions. Typical remedial actions have included re-glassing, adjustments or repairs to rudder posts, and replacement of failed plastic thru-hulls and cracked seals; therefore, commissioning an independent survey before acceptance is strongly recommended. The use of triple Volvo Penta IPS pods and options like a Seakeeper improve handling and comfort but also introduce more specialized servicing requirements and potentially higher maintenance costs.

Pros and Cons

- Joystick/IPS control makes the Fly 78 user-friendly for owner-operators handling tight berths and close-quarters maneuvers.
- Reported performance supports a typical cruise of 26–27 kt with top speeds in the 31–33 kt range under normal conditions.
- The four-cabin layout with a full-beam master, together with generous flybridge and foredeck social spaces, fits family cruising and light charter needs.
- Multiple reports of unfinished fiberglass areas, leaking hatches/window seals, and loose screws have required post-delivery remedial attention.
- Owners have experienced warranty friction; engaging an independent survey prior to final acceptance is advisable.

- Triple IPS pods and an optional Seakeeper enhance onboard comfort and handling but increase the complexity and cost of specialist servicing.
