OVERVIEW

The Flybridge Evolution from Azimut Yachts is a 62 ft (18.9 m) motor yacht built on a fiberglass and plastic hull, engineered to pair a roomy platform with twin CAT inboard diesels for assured performance and plentiful tankage. This model is offered by Shestakov Yacht Sales with dedicated brokerage support from Andrey Shestakov.

Selecting a Flybridge Evolution

Opting for the Flybridge Evolution is a smart choice if you appreciate an established motor yacht silhouette from Azimut Yachts, a typical cruising pace near 25 knots with reserve capability to about 30 knots, and the convenience of four heads for guests and family. With a 16 ft (5.03 m) beam and substantial fuel and water capacities, it is well suited to extended coastal passages and entertaining afloat. Be mindful of the maximum draft of 15.584 ft (4.75 m) when arranging marina berths and passage planning. Shestakov Yacht Sales, led by Andrey Shestakov, can assist in matching this model to your cruising program and coordinating delivery timing.

Questions and Answers

- Q: What are the top and cruising speeds of the Flybridge Evolution? A: The yacht offers a cruising **speed** of 25 knots (about 28.77 mph) and a **maximum speed** of 30 knots (about 34.52 mph).
- Q: What powers this motor yacht? A: Twin **CAT** engines with **Inboard**

installation running on **Diesel** provide reliable performance.

- Q: What are the key dimensions and draft? A: LOA is 62 ft (18.9 m), beam is 16 ft (5.03 m), and **max draft** is 15.584 ft (4.75 m).
- Q: What capacities support longer trips? A: The yacht carries about 3,739.99 gal of **fuel** and 999.35 gal of **water** , supporting extended cruising plans.
- Q: What materials are used for the hull and deck? A: The hull is fiberglass and plastic, and the **deck** is Fiberglass. For ordering details, coordinate with Shestakov Yacht Sales and Andrey Shestakov.

Owner Experience Review

Owners tend to choose the Flybridge Evolution from Azimut Yachts for family-oriented coastal cruising, weekend socializing aboard, and occasional light charter or day-use operations. Layouts with three cabins and multiple heads, an expansive flybridge, and an open saloon-to-cockpit flow create an environment well suited to entertaining guests. Interior appointments are frequently praised for being contemporary and well styled, featuring designer touches and the model's characteristic shark fin saloon windows, though several owners do report variation in fit and finish from unit to unit.

Underway, owners describe a planted, deep V hull feel and a comfortable ride when encountering chop. The model is often characterized as responsive and relatively quick. A 2007 specification referenced an approximate 25 knot cruise and an approximate 30 knot top speed, that example also being fitted with CAT power.

Ownership feedback also highlights practical maintenance realities: some owners have replaced pumps, various electrical components, toilets, windscreens, and water lines, and undertaken teak repairs as well as gelcoat touch ups or repainting. There are frequent reports of delayed warranty work and parts lead times, along with isolated corrosion or exterior finish issues on

stainless fittings during early production runs. A number of newer deliveries experienced early engine related teething problems. Experiences depend on the individual boat and the servicing network, so planning for proactive maintenance and realistic lead times is commonly advised.

Pros and Cons

- Spacious flybridge and social layout suit family cruising and weekend entertaining.
- Stable deep V ride with smooth manners in chop; responsive handling.
- Solid performance for the class, with about 25 knot cruise and ~30 knot top speed noted on a 2007 spec.
- Reports of variable fit-and-finish and early interior-system failures requiring replacements.
- Warranty and parts delays often cited, leading to extended downtime.
- Isolated cases of corrosion/finish issues on exterior fittings and early engine teething on some newer deliveries.
