The GRANDE 25 METRI from Azimut Yachts represents a sophisticated motor yacht within the motor yachts category, built on a fiberglass and plastic foundation and featuring a planing hull engineered for assured, high-speed passages. Capable of a 24 kn (about 27.62 mph) cruise and a 28 kn (about 32.22 mph) top end, it combines lively performance with the onboard volume to entertain larger parties. Q: What are the performance figures for the GRANDE 25 METRI? A: The yacht is specified to cruise at **24 kn** with a maximum speed of **28 kn** (approximately **27.62 mph** and **32.22 mph**), enabled by its planing hull and twin **MAN** inboard **diesel** propulsion.

Q: What is the hull and deck construction? A: The vessel's hull is constructed from fiberglass and plastic, while the deck is finished in **GRP** , balancing structural robustness with weight efficiency.

Q: How many people can stay aboard and sleep comfortably? A: Accommodation is listed for **16** people overall, with **8** dedicated sleeping berths, **5** heads and **2** crew berths to support operations and guest service.

Q: Who designed the interior of this motor yacht by Azimut Yachts? A: The interior design is by **Salvagni** , delivering refined finishes and a contemporary palette suited to extended cruising and entertaining.

Owner Experience Review

Owners commonly select the GRANDE 25 METRI for family-focused private cruising, often keeping utilization low and avoiding commercial chartering. With CE A classification and a fuel capacity that supports longer passages, the model is capable of coastal and modest offshore runs. The planing hull engineered by PLANA Design, Carbon-Tech superstructure and handling aids such as Active Trim and electronic power steering all contribute to a confident, responsive helm feel; owners typically report comfortable cruising at 23–24 knots and peak speeds near 27–29 knots depending on the selected MAN 1,650/1,800 hp engine option. Experienced skippers extract the best performance across mixed offshore conditions.

A typical four-stateroom lower-deck arrangement includes a full-beam master that spans the yacht's 20-foot-4-inch beam, while Achille Salvagni's interior

schemes create a bright, open main salon. Expansive exterior living spaces—an instrumented flybridge with hardtop, a sundeck with jacuzzi and a dedicated tender garage—are designed for active family use. Separate crew quarters and service circulation routes preserve owner privacy on longer voyages.

Feedback from owners is mixed regarding build consistency: some reports on Azimut Yachts note issues such as unfinished fiberglass in bilge areas or loose fastenings discovered after short trips, and online discussions recount challenging warranty interactions, including an account of legal threats after defect disclosure. Many brokerage examples, however, show comprehensive service histories and low engine hours; a number of owners choose to undertake upgrades or refits (one cited an investment near \$250,000). The twin MAN V12s (1,650–1,800 hp) carry typical high-power diesel maintenance demands, so buyers place value on ample engine-room access and documented servicing records.

Pros and Cons

- Four-stateroom layout with a full-beam master and Achille Salvagni interiors suits family cruising.
- Sporty, responsive handling with a typical 23–24-knot cruise and 27–29-knot top, aided by Active Trim and electronic steering.
- CE A rating, fuel capacity, and separate crew spaces support longer coastal runs with privacy.
- Fit-and-finish variability has been reported on some Azimut Yachts builds.
- Online owner threads describe difficult warranty claims and even legal pushback.
- The yacht rewards a skilled helm for best results in offshore conditions and trim.
