OVERVIEW

The Grande 27 Metri from Azimut Yachts is a motor yacht built on a fiberglass and plastic hull. Offering 145 GT of usable space, sporting handling characteristics and interiors penned by Salvagni, it's marketed by Shestakov Yacht Sales with Andrey Shestakov as broker. The model combines assured seakeeping with refined detailing for comfortable long-distance cruising.

Selecting a Grande 27 Metri

Owners wanting a yacht that balances internal volume with sporty performance will find the Grande 27 Metri compelling at 87 ft (26.78 m) LOA, a 21 ft (6.59 m) beam and a 6.332 ft (1.93 m) draft. Propelled by twin MAN inboard diesel units, she comfortably cruises at 24 knots and can reach about 28 knots at top end, while 145 GT supplies substantial interior room detailed by Salvagni. Configured to sleep up to 10 guests with 5 heads, and supported by large fuel (2509.63 gal) and water (528.34 gal) tanks, she is well suited to family voyaging and entertaining afloat.

- Q: What type of yacht is the Grande 27 Metri and what is its hull? A: It is a motor yacht built on a fiberglass and plastic hull by Azimut Yachts. The **type** and **hull** choices are intended to combine performance with a refined onboard

experience.

- Q: What are the speeds of the Grande 27 Metri? A: The vessel's **cruising speed** is 24 kn (27.62 mph) and the **maximum speed** is 28 kn (32.22 mph), providing brisk passage making when required.
- Q: What powers the yacht? A: Propulsion comes from two MAN **engines** in an **inboard** configuration, running on **diesel**, delivering dependable thrust and efficiency.
- Q: How many people can stay on board and how many heads are there? A: The yacht offers **accommodations** for up to 10 guests and includes **5 heads**, making her suitable for family use and guest hosting.

Owner Experience Review

Owners are often attracted to the Grande 27 Metri from Azimut Yachts for relaxed family cruising, occasional charter work and lively weekend entertaining. The main deck, full beam owner's cabin—accentuated by broad glazing—receives frequent praise for its light and privacy, while adaptable 4–5 cabin arrangements and dedicated crew quarters for 3–4 enhance flexibility for owner operators or fully crewed operations. The salon's single level flow, concealed galley and premium finishes are generally well executed, although the custom materials can increase maintenance and repair complexity.

On passage she handles like a high performance planing yacht: sea trials and owner reports cite comfortable cruising in the mid 20 knot range and peak speeds near 28 knots, with steady behavior for an 87 foot planing hull. The elevated pilothouse affords clear forward sightlines. The aft mounted engines on V drives allow the main deck owner configuration but have prompted

commentary about vibration and acoustic characteristics and their implications for machinery layout and access.

From a maintenance perspective, the engine room is walk around, yet the V drive setup and densely packed systems can restrict access for some servicing tasks, so thorough surveys of individual hulls are advisable. Builder and engine warranties plus an extensive dealer/service network are advantages, though forum discussions record occasional after sales disputes and isolated finish issues such as loose fittings or untreated fiberglass in bilge areas. Operating and service budgets are in superyacht ranges, and most owners plan for professional crew and documented maintenance programs.

Pros and Cons

- Full beam main deck owner's suite with large glazing offers notable comfort and privacy.
- Sporty planing hull delivers mid 20 knot cruising with an approximate 28 knot top end and strong forward visibility from the raised pilothouse.
- Versatile 4-5 cabin plans, proper crew accommodations and beach club/terrace options make it well suited to family life and enhance charter potential.
- V drive configuration can introduce vibration and noise challenges and complicate some service access.
- Overall ownership expenses are in superyacht territory, frequently necessitating professional crew and careful financial planning.
- Online forums note occasional warranty/after sales disputes and isolated build finish issues on select boats.
