## OVERVIEW

---

The Grande 30M from Azimut Yachts is a modern motor yacht designed in the mega yacht class and built on a fiberglass and plastic hull. Presented by Andrey Shestakov and Shestakov Yacht Sales, this 98 ft (30 m) platform combines assured performance, generous internal volume, and styling from P.L. AUSONIO Naval Architecture & Azimut R&D Dept with interiors by M2Atelier.

## Selecting a Grande 30M

---

For buyers seeking a near-30-metre yacht that pairs strong performance with roomy guest accommodations, the Grande 30M is a compelling choice. With an overall length of 98 ft (30 m), a beam of 24 ft (7.3 m), and a maximum draft of 6.627 ft (2.02 m), it offers a compromise between seakeeping capability and access to a broad range of cruising destinations. The layout sleeps up to 10 guests with 6 heads and provides crew quarters configured as 3 cabins with 6 berths, making it suitable for private family use or charter-style entertaining. ## Questions and Answers

---

- What is the yacht's classification and build approach? The Grande 30M is a motor yacht within the mega yacht sector, constructed on a fiberglass and plastic hull in a monohull format by P.L. AUSONIO Naval Architecture & Azimut

R&D Dept. **Type** and **hull** details emphasize both efficient performance and onboard comfort.

- What are the key dimensions? **Dimensions** : LOA 98 ft (30 m), beam 24 ft (7.3 m), and max draft 6.627 ft (2.02 m). These figures deliver a balance of internal volume and capable handling at sea.
- How is it powered and how fast does it go? The yacht is driven by **2 MTU inboard diesel** engines, providing a **22 kn** cruising speed (25.32 mph) and a **28 kn** maximum (32.22 mph).
- How many guests and crew can it accommodate? **Accommodation** includes berths for 10 guests with 6 heads. **Crew** quarters consist of 3 cabins offering 6 berths to support professional service aboard.

## Owner Experience Review

---

Initial owner use of the Grande 30M has ranged from family-operated cruising to social weekend entertaining; the first hull was delivered to a repeat Azimut Yachts client who intends to base the yacht in Sai Kung. The design brief clearly focuses on entertaining: the extended flybridge/Infinity Skydeck, the Glass House skylounge that can enclose and open on three sides, the Deck2Deck transom extension, and a spacious cockpit combine to create generous alfresco dining and large-group hosting zones. For longer passages, the compact professional-style galley and dedicated crew accommodations enable full-service operation.

On the move, owners note a robust Grande hull built around a double-chine D2P geometry with a wave-piercing bow. The twin MTUs paired with ZF pods reportedly improve close-quarters maneuvering and reduce driveline vibration versus conventional shaft arrangements, with quoted top speeds near 25

knots and cruising closer to ~20 knots. Published fuel figures—approximately 12,000 liters—translate to roughly 613 nautical miles at about 13.2 knots and around 376 nautical miles at ~24 knots, reflecting the yacht’s hybrid role rather than long-distance passagemaking at high speed.

Comfort both underway and at anchor benefits from a saloon with a seamless, no-step transition from cockpit to interior, alongside a full-beam main-deck owner’s stateroom and four guest cabins accommodating up to 10 people. Ownership notes include the need for pod-specific servicing and specialized access within the aft technical spaces, even as pod installation frees volume in lower compartments. Owner-community feedback has highlighted after-sales and workmanship concerns with Azimut Yachts—from unfinished fiberglass in bilges to loose fasteners and disputed warranty cases—so prospective purchasers should assess local service support carefully. Broader, long-term owner data on the Grande 30M is still limited as deliveries increase.

## Pros and Cons

---

- Standout social layout with Infinity Skydeck, an enclosable Glass House skylounge, Deck2Deck transom, and a large cockpit for alfresco hosting.
- D2P hull with wave-piercing bow and MTU+ZF pods deliver good sea-keeping, a ~25-knot top end, and easier, lower-vibration handling.
- Main-deck full-beam owner’s suite, four guest cabins (up to 10), and a compact pro-style galley suit both owner-operated and crewed trips.
- Pod propulsion introduces specialized servicing needs and reliance on OEM pathways.
- At faster cruise (~24 knots), published range is about 376 nm, limiting longer passages at speed.
- Owner-community reports cite warranty disputes and workmanship issues with Azimut Yachts, including unfinished fiberglass and loose screws.
