The GRANDE 32 METRI from Azimut Yachts is a modern motor yacht built with a fiberglass and plastic hull and GRP decks. With interiors by Achille Salvagni Architetti, a typical cruising speed of 21 kn (24.17 mph), and accommodation for 10, it merges performance, interior volume, and refined styling. Selecting a GRANDE 32 METRI

Opting for the GRANDE 32 METRI appeals to buyers seeking a 105 ft (32 m) yacht that pairs a 26 kn top speed with elegant Italian design. As a motor yacht, it is versatile for a range of cruising profiles, while its fiberglass and plastic monohull construction promotes efficient operation and predictable handling. With sleeping space for 10 and 6 heads, it's well suited to extended family voyages or entertaining onboard.

Features of the Model

- Dimensions that create both presence and onboard comfort: 105 ft LOA (32 m), 24 ft beam (7.3 m), and a 6.201 ft (1.89 m) draft.
- Confident performance envelope: 21 kn cruising speed and a 26 kn top speed for flexible itinerary planning.
- Twin MTU inboard diesel propulsion delivering robust, serviceable power.
- Interiors by Achille Salvagni Architetti, configured to sleep 10 with 6 heads to maximize guest privacy and comfort.
- Construction particulars: a fiberglass and plastic hull, GRP deck, and a monohull layout.

Questions and Answers

Q: What is the performance profile of the GRANDE 32 METRI? A: It delivers a **cruising speed** of 21 kn (24.17 mph) and a **maximum speed** of 26 kn (29.92 mph), offering a balance between efficient passage making and brisk transit.

Q: How is the yacht categorized and built? A: The model is a motor yacht with a **monohull** form, constructed from fiberglass and plastic and finished with a **GRP** deck to provide lightweight strength and durability.

Q: What are the accommodations like? A: Accommodation is planned for **10 guests** across cabins with **6 heads**, all specified by **Achille Salvagni Architeti** to deliver an upscale onboard environment.

Q: What powers the vessel? A: The yacht is driven by **2 MTU inboard diesel** engines, supplying reliable propulsion and common global support for servicing.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and brokers describe the GRANDE 32 METRI from Azimut Yachts as a flexible platform for family cruising and refined entertaining, featuring a full beam owner's stateroom on the main deck and five guest cabins that simplify hosting. The Achille Salvagni interior is repeatedly praised as luxurious, with adaptable layouts (owners have repurposed cabins into gyms), while a very large flybridge of roughly 70 m², a generous foredeck lounge, and a beach club with a lateral tender garage enhance charter and social functionality. Underway, reviewers note a semi /fast displacement hull that

typically cruises in the 20–22 kn range and can reach about 26.5 kn when fitted with twin MTU 16V2000 M86 engines, providing steady behavior in chop and improved at anchor comfort when fitted with zero speed stabilisers. It performs well for both short breaks and longer voyages, though owners caution that achieving optimal fuel economy and confident high speed handling benefits from an experienced captain; plan for higher running and maintenance demands on stabilisers, air conditioning systems, generators, and fuel filtration, and heed forum reports of finish and warranty friction by commissioning an Azimut Yachts experienced surveyor for detailed pre purchase inspections.

Pros and Cons

- Full beam main deck owner's suite with full height windows creates exceptional natural light and a villa like ambiance.
- Very large flybridge, roomy foredeck lounge, and beach club with a lateral tender garage make the yacht well suited to entertaining and charter work.
- Semi /fast displacement hull with an observed 20–22 kn cruise and about a 26.5 kn top speed delivers confident performance and, when equipped, zero speed stabilisers enhance comfort.
- Achieving the best fuel economy and predictable high speed handling typically requires an experienced captain rather than a novice operator.
- Owners and brokers report elevated running and servicing costs for stabilisers, AC systems, generators, and fuel filtration.
- Forum and broker feedback points to occasional finish and warranty friction; a pre purchase survey by an Azimut Yachts knowledgeable expert is recommended.
