Measuring 118 ft (36 m) overall, the layout supports up to 12 guests and spans a wide 24 ft (7.5 m) beam, delivering substantial interior volume at 279 gross tons. Twin MTU inboard diesels enable a practical 18 knot cruise and a 24 knot maximum, making it suitable for efficient passages and punctual arrivals. ## Owner Experience Review

---

For owners, the GRANDE 36M from Azimut Yachts frequently represents an ideal Mediterranean family platform: it delivers near superyacht space without obligating a permanent onboard crew. Many operators favor owner occupied seasonal use, leveraging a main deck master suite and several guest cabins, while expansive exterior living areas—such as the Infinity Skydeck and a configurable skylounge—support entertaining and occasional chartering.

On the water, the D2P hull with a wave piercing bow is often praised for its displacement mode comfort and for transitioning to semi planing in an efficient, controlled manner. Owner reports and listings point to steady handling in choppy seas and reduced roll attributed to the carbon fiber superstructure and hull engineering. Common performance claims cite top speeds near 24 knots with economical cruising in the 18–19 knot band, consistent with twin MTU 16V 2000 installations.

Inside, owners and industry reviewers commend the light, unobstructed interiors with large glazing and Achille Salvagni's signature aesthetic; the

Skydeck and skylounge layouts—configured for dining, cinema, or relaxation—add daily flexibility. That said, long term ownership requires planning for specialist maintenance, particularly for carbon fiber components and advanced onboard systems. Annual routine budgets are frequently estimated in the \$150k–\$200k range, with a 5 year refit projection of roughly \$500k–\$750k. Forum commentary across the Azimut Yachts community also highlights occasional build quality and warranty matters, so comprehensive surveys and post delivery remedial work are advisable.

## Pros and Cons

- Pro: The D2P hull with a wave piercing bow provides comfortable displacement performance and a smooth, efficient shift toward planing.
- Pro: Bright, barrier free interiors by Achille Salvagni combined with the Infinity Skydeck and skylounge offer adaptable indoor-outdoor living.
- Pro: Well suited to family cruising without a full time crew while also serving effectively as an entertaining or charter platform.
- Con: Typical annual servicing costs are often budgeted around \$150k–\$200k, with many owners allocating \$500k–\$750k for a 5 year refit cycle.
- Con: Carbon fiber elements and advanced systems demand specialist maintenance and experienced service providers.
- Con: Community reports across the Azimut Yachts fleet mention build quality and warranty challenges, so detailed surveys and post delivery punch lists are recommended.
