The Italia from Baia is a 70 ft performance motor yacht built in fiberglass with a Deep Vee hull form. It cruises comfortably at 32 knots (36.83 mph) and can reach a top speed of 50 knots (57.54 mph). Presented by Andrey Shestakov and the team at Shestakov Yacht Sales.

Q: What performance should I expect from the Italia? A: The model provides a **cruise speed of 32 knots (36.83 mph)** and a **top speed of 50 knots (57.54 mph)** , delivering the swift, agile character typical of a motor yacht by Baia.

Q: How shallow can the Italia safely operate? A: With a **draft of 3.445 ft (1.05 m)** combined with its Deep Vee hull, the yacht is well-suited to coastal cruising and approaches where reduced depth is an advantage.

Q: How many people can sleep aboard? A: The interior layout provides accommodation for **up to 10 guests** (sleeps 10), making it flexible for family outings or hosting friends.

Owner Experience Review

Owners and operators typically describe the Italia from Baia as a late 2000s express performer that comfortably bridges high speed passages and Mediterranean day charter duties, with multiple listings out of Ibiza reflecting that usage. In trials and owner reports the boat delivers a spirited sports boat sensation via Arneson surface drives, with professional sea trials recording near 58 mph; once on plane the vessel maintains a firm, composed motion in 2–3 ft chop.

The onboard arrangement caters well to family cruising and weekend escapes: common layouts feature four cabins plus a two berth crew area, and the glass house/open deck concept with large aft doors opens the main deck into a spacious social zone. Observers have noted the unusually light, deeply grained wenge hardwood finish and attributed the styling to Carlo Galeazzi.

Handling requires attention to loading and trim—owners and forum discussions caution that excess weight can delay planing, and that low speed maneuvering is often less forgiving than shaft drive counterparts.

Maintenance is specific to the Arneson configuration: specialist servicing, routine oil and zinc checks around the 200 hour interval, keeping running gear clean to avoid prop fouling, and regular inspection of drive and ram boots to preserve seals. Some feedback on older Baia examples mentions restricted access and inconsistent wiring that can complicate troubleshooting, along with legacy engine items such as turbochargers and fuel system components needing attention.

Pros and Cons

- Sea trials and owner reports indicate near 58 mph top speeds driven by efficient, lively Arneson surface drives.
- Glass house main deck with large aft doors and a 4 cabin plus crew layout works well for families and charter operations.
- When on plane the yacht delivers a firm, confident ride in 2–3 ft chop.
- Sensitive to weight and trim; overloading can make achieving plane difficult.
- Low speed maneuverability is reduced compared with shaft drive equivalents.
- Arneson drives require specialist maintenance, periodic checks, clean propellers, and attention to seals and booting.

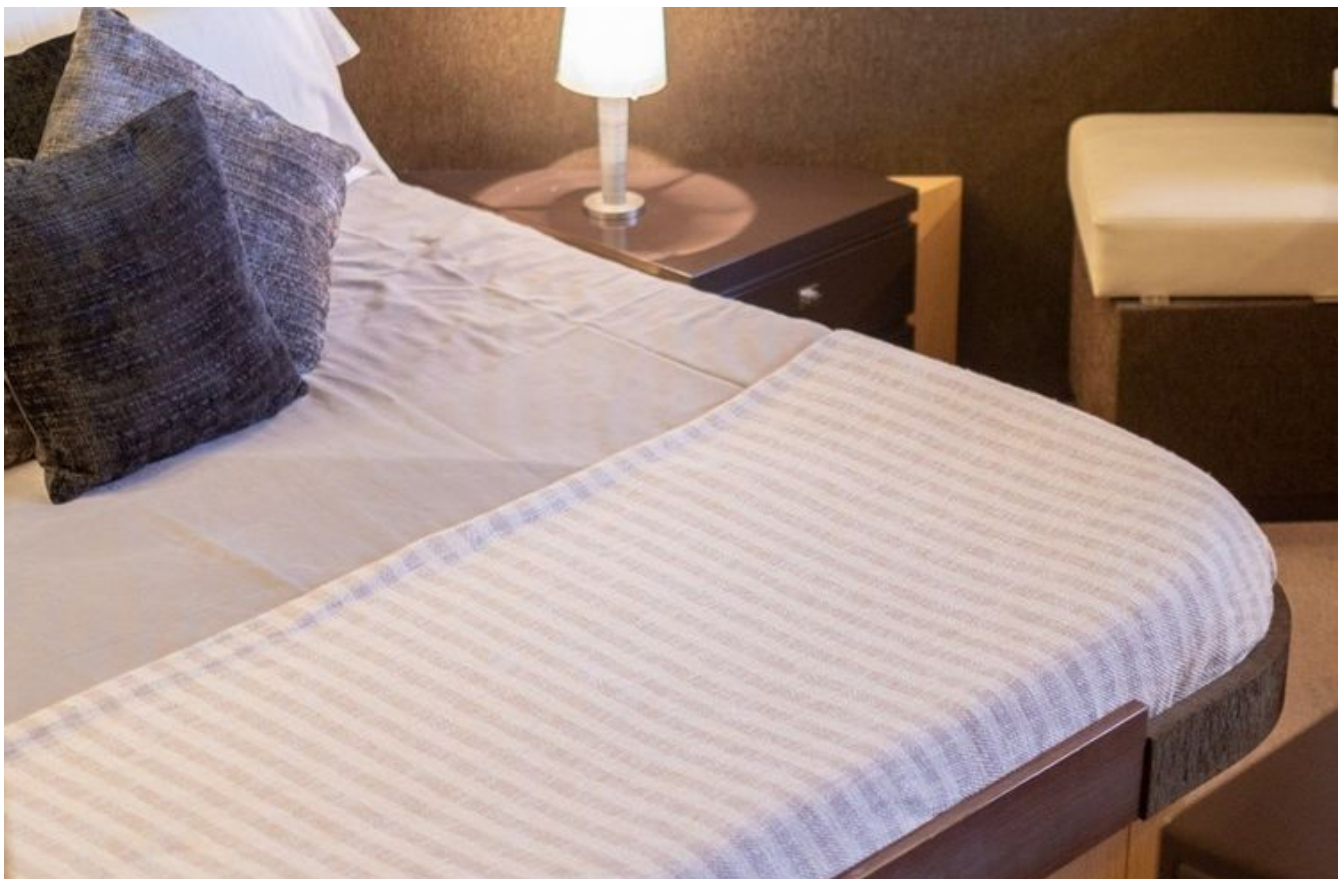
